QUICK START

- 1. The goal is to complete your map puzzle of your hometown before anyone else.
- 2. Every player starts by taking 25 pieces from the bag.
- 3. Complete as much of your map puzzle as you can, and keep the extra pieces aside
- 4. Each player takes turns to pick a piece out of the bag and must place a piece back in the bag.
- 5. If you put a wild piece back in the bag, the player must do what it says (this is when the fun really starts)
- 6. Whoever finishes their puzzle first is the winner!

HOW TO PLAY | 4 PLAYERS

Place all the map puzzle pieces and wild puzzle pieces in the cloth bag and shake well to mix. Each player takes 25 puzzle pieces from the bag. Once all players have taken their pieces, there should be 25 pieces still left in the bag ready for when the game begins.

Each player then completes as much of their map puzzle as they can with the pieces that they have taken from the bag. Each player should keep any spare map pieces and any wild puzzle pieces to one side for game playing.

You are now ready to play!

GAME PLAY

The aim of the game is to complete your map puzzle before anyone-else!

The first player takes a piece from the bag. If it's a piece that fits in their puzzle, that's great. They can place it in their puzzle! BUT the player then must put another one of their pieces back in the bag (each player will always have 25 pieces at the end of their turn).

If the piece chosen from the bag is not useful, there are 3 options:

- i. Put that piece back in the bag
- ii. Keep it and put another of their map pieces back in the bag
- iii. Keep it and play a wild puzzle piece. (See using your wild puzzle piece section)

The next player then takes their turn taking a piece from the bag and either choosing to put it back in or keeping it and placing one of their pieces back in the bag. And so on.

Read our 'important Hints and tips' to help you play the game.

USING YOUR WILD PUZZLE PIECES

If a wild puzzle piece is taken from the bag, the player can choose to use it there and then by placing it back in to the bag, or save it for later by keeping it and placing a different piece back in to the bag.

If the player decides to put a wild puzzle piece back in the bag, the rule on the wild puzzle piece must be followed. For example if they play a 'miss a go' wild puzzle piece, the next player will miss a go, or if they play a 'reverse' puzzle piece then this reverses the direction of play.



REVERSE The direction of play reverses. (No of pieces: 5)



HAVE ANOTHER GO

The player who puts this piece back in the bag, has another go. (No of pieces: 6)



MISS A GO The next player misses their go! (No of pieces: 6)



BOARD SWAP

The player who plays this piece swaps all their pieces with another player of their choice! Be careful how you use this one it could go either way!





PIECE SWAP

The player who plays this puzzle pieces takes any piece from any other player and gives them one of their pieces. The player who plays this piece decides which piece to TAKE from the other player and which piece to GIVE the other player.

IMPORTANT HINTS & TIPS

When putting the puzzle together start with the outside straight edges and see your hometown come to life as you build it piece by piece.

Each finished puzzle will have five rows and five columns of puzzle pieces.

You always start your go by taking a piece from the bag, make sure that you always put one back in. You should always hold 25 pieces at the end of your go.

The wild puzzle pieces are your weapons! You can use these to change the game, so use them wisely

You can shorten the game by not putting wild puzzle pieces back in the bag, putting them aside and only putting map puzzle pieces in.
