GEWA Violin/Viola Case Subway Handle Retrofit Installation, Oblong

Product Line: Air, Idea

Instrument: Violin, Viola

Shape: Oblong

Size: All

Difficulty: Medium. May require special tools, volatile solvent, and special skills.

Required Tools and Material

- Drill
- 4mm or 5/32 drill bit
- 1/32 drill bit
- Screwdriver
- Rivet gun
- Masking tape
- Ruler
- Grease pen or any removable pen on thermoplastic
- Permanent marker
- Acetone
- Heat gun
- Fabric glue

Assumptions and Terminologies

- Left side hinge side
- Right side main handle side

Handle Installation

- 1. Set the case's hinge side on a flat hard surface.
- 2. Set the ruler against the short sides
- 3. Measure and mark the point 5 3/8" from the bottom of the ruler with grease pen. This is the mid-point between the 2 hardware
- 4. Repeat Step 3 for the other short side.
- 5. Measure and mark the *line* at 3 3/16" from the center to the main handle side. This is where the outer edge of the right-side hardware will be. Repeat the process for the left side
- 6. Mark 3/8" from the bottom shell's rubber valance on both lines made in step (iv).
- 7. Apply masking tape to connect the hardware outer edge lines made in the step 4 at the 3/8" marks made in the step 5. Do not hide the outer edge lines. If hidden, draw a new line on the masking tape.

- 8. Place a hardware on the right side so that the hardware's top and the right edges will align the edges of the masking tape.
- 9. While holding the hardware in place, mark the center points of the rivet holes.
- 10. Repeat steps 7 and 8 for the left side
- 11. Using acetone, peel back the interior lining where the rivet holes will be made.
- 12. Drill through the shell at the rivet hole marks made in step 8. Do not apply strong pressure and do not let the drill bit catch the interior fabric.
- 13. Place a D-ring in the slot on the D-ring plate, then align the rivet holes with the holes made in step 10
- 14. Insert a rivet from outside, black end first. Once through, put a washer on the black end.
- 15. Fasten the rivet according to the rivet gun instruction. Repeat for the other plate.
- 16. If needed, apply acetone on the interior lining to soften the glue
- 17. Reattach the lining to cover the rivets while applying light pressure with hand and hot air from the heat gun set at 240F
- 18. Install the leather handle.

Rubber bumper installation

- 1. Mark the center mark of the rubber bumper (1 3/8" from the edge)
- 2. Place the rubber bumper on the case surface and align the bumper center mark with the case center mark made in step 3 under Handle Installation.
- 3. Mark the screw hole
- 4. Drill pilot holes using 1/32 drill bit
- 5. Secure the rubber bumper with supplied screws
