

Advent Calendar using 3", 4" or 5" Quilt As You Go House template



Instructions for Advent Calendar

Requirements:

	3"	4"	5"
Backing fabric : (110cm wide)	50cm	80cm	115cm
Main Fabric and Wadding: (110cm wide)	25cm	48cm	80cm
Pockets: (110cm wide)	16cm	32cm	52cm

Numbers required:

13 x number 1	2 x number 6
9 x number 2	2 x number 7
3 x number 3	2 x number 8
3 x number 4	2 x number 9
3 x number 5	2 x number 0

Cut 25 houses and (depending what size house you are making) cut 25 x 3", 4" or 5" squares relevant to the size house (these are for the pockets).

On each pocket double turn a ¼" on one edge and top stitch. This is the pocket opening.

On each pocket applique numbers 1-25 centrally, if you finger press the pocket in half length and width ways you will get the centre and then place the number (or numbers) in a central position and right way up!!

Once pockets are finished place each one on top of a central house (with the finished edge at the top). Tack the two side seams and lower edge.

Now make up the houses as per the original instructions.

Now lay out all your houses (random order) in 5 x rows of 5. (see diagram)

Ladder stitch the sides together.

To join the rows together find the centre point of bottom edge of the house above and sew the roof point onto this point. Do this for every house that is connected.

You can hang your advent calendar either with ribbons or a quilt hanging sleeve.
