HOW MUCH TO ORDER

NOTE: Our removable wallpaper is sold in 10.67 foot rolls. This is perfect for one drop (length) of wallpaper with an 8-9' wall height. If you have ceilings taller than 9' please contact sales@thatcherstudio.com to order an extra long roll.

Take the width of your wall in inches and divide by 24, round up to nearest whole number. THIS IS THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF ROLLS YOU SHOULD ORDER. We recommend ordering at least one extra roll for overage*.

*Overage: Since Thatcher removable wallpapers are printed to order, there can be slight variations between batches. To ensure you will have enough for your project and "attic stock" in case you need to replace a drop in the future, we recommend overage (extra) of one to two rolls. Overage is not returnable - save it for attic stock if not used.

Inspect your rolls for print flaws as soon as you receive them, before cutting or peeling. Please do not cut any wallpaper prior to examining. By cutting or otherwise using the product, the product is considered acceptable and is not eligible for a claim.

DO NOT APPLY REMOVABLE WALLPAPER TO PLACES WHERE YOUNG CHILDREN MAY REMOVE WHILE UNATTENDED, SUCH AS CRIBS.

HANGING INSTRUCTIONS

You will need: Measuring tape Pencil Exacto knife Level and/or plumb bob (recommended)

1. Double check you have enough wallpaper rolls to complete your project. Inspect the wallpaper. Once cut, no claims of a print flaw may be made.

2. Prep your wall by washing with a damp cloth and allow it to dry fully. Make sure you have a smooth surface in good condition. If you have recently painted, allow it to cure for about a month before installing.

3. Start in the most visible corner. Using a level or plumb bob, create a vertical plumb line 24" to the edge of your wall with a pencil. You will follow this down the wall to make sure you have a straight application.

4. Peel the backing from your paper about 6" at the top, align the side of the panel along your vertical pencil line from the ceiling down, gently removing and adjusting until plumb. When you are happy with the placement, begin pressing the paper onto the wall, moving from the center out and down, pushing any air bubbles to the edges. Continue peeling the backing in small sections down the roll as you apply. Trim as needed at the bottom.

This is what is referred to as a 'drop', the continuous application from a single roll, from ceiling to floor.



5. For the second drop, you will need match your pattern repeat. With a half-drop pattern, such as this one, the pattern repeat will match at 16" down from the top of your roll. We suggest trimming about 12" from the top and aligning the pattern along the edge to match your previous drop. Then, as you did before, peel back about 6" and adjust until you are happy with the alignment. Trim the excess few inches from the top and continue down the wall, trimming at the bottom of the wall.



6. Alternate instructions #4 and #5 until you reach the end of the wall. Trim with a straight ruler and exacto knife at the wall edge.

WHAT CAN I DO WITH THE EXTRA WALLPAPER TRIMMINGS?

Many of our customers save the wallpaper trimmings that are large enough to line drawers or the inside of a bookcase. Just keep the backing on and save for the perfect project!

RETURNS

In general, we do not accept returns. However, in the rare case that any wallpaper is deemed defective due to a print flaw, etc., we will exchange and replace any defective wallpaper. Please do not cut any wallpaper prior to examining. Please read details:

Examination of the paper prior to hanging is the buyer's responsibility. Ensure that all rolls are the correct color and pattern, are all part of the same dye lot, have no variation in color, have no print flaws, and that there are enough rolls to complete the job. If any errors in the aforementioned are found, we ask that you contact us right away, and we will promptly reply. Do not cut any of the wallpaper (even rolls deemed fit) in your order prior to speaking with us. By cutting the wallpaper, the buyer/installer has approved the wallpaper for use, and no claims for return may be made. Please note that Thatcher will exchange but not refund any wallpaper that is deemed unfit for use.

SALE OF GOODS

We sell all of our products with the belief that they are of suitable quality and will serve their intended purpose. You as the customer must take into account your particular situation and the conditions of the intended site. Any and all defects must be reported immediately when discovered, prior to cutting the wallpaper, and within two weeks of purchase. Our liability will not exceed the purchase price and/or invoiced value of the goods in question.
