

# MOSAIC SLIPPERS



Inspired by our Grandma's, here is a pattern of traditional slippers, passed down from mother to daughter, that will warm your feet "à la mode de chez nous"... Enjoy your knitting!

**TAILLES :** ADULT ONE SIZE

## MATERIALS

- ◆ 2 x 100g of [Briggs & Little « Tuffy »](#) : 1 skein of main color (MC) and 1 skein of contrasting color (CC)
- ◆ [Straight needles](#) of 4.5 mm (US#7)
- ◆ [Tapestry needle](#)

## HEEL (with MC)

Cast-on 29 sts and work the following 6 rows :

**Row 1 (RS) :** K12, [Kf/b] x5, k12 (34 sts)

**Rows 2, 4 & 6 (WS) :** knit

**Row 3 (RS) :** k14, [Kf/b] x6, k14 (40 sts)

**Row 5 (RS) :** K14, [Kf/b] x3, k6, [Kf/b] x3, k14 (46 sts)

## FOOT (alternating MC and CC)

**NOTE :** At the beginning of the rows, do not cross the 2 yarns, the hole that forms between the 2nd and 3rd stitch will be closed when sewing the slipper.

**Rows 1 & 3 (RS) with CC :** repeat [sl2 (MC) as if to purl, k2 CC] to the end of row, end with sl2 (MC) as if to purl.

**Rows 2 & 4 (WS) with CC :** repeat [gl 2m (MC) as if to purl, p2 with CC] to the end of row, sl2 (MC) as if to purl.

**Rows 5 to 8 with MC :** knit.

Repeat rows 1 to 8 again 10 to 11 times and work one last time rows 1 to 6 only and move to the next step.

## CLOSING

**Row 1 (RS) with MC :** repeat [k2tog, k2] to the last 2 sts, k2tog (34 sts)

**Row 2 (WS) with MC :** knit.

**Row 3 (RS) with CC :** repeat [sl1 (MC) as if to purl, k2 with CC] to the last st, sl1 (MC) as if to purl.

**Row 4 (WS) with CC :** repeat [sl1 (MC) as if to purl, p2 with CC] to the last st, sl1 (MC) as if to purl.

Cut CC, leaving a tail of about 30 cm: from now on will work with MC only.

**Rows 5 & 6 :** knit.

**Row 7 (RS) :** repeat [1end, k2tog] to the end of row (23 sts)

**Row 8 (WS) :** knit.

**Row 9 (RS) :** repeat [k2tog, k1] to the end of row (15 sts)

**Row 10 (WS) :** knit.

Close the ends and sew the top of the foot at the desired length. Concerning the holes formed between the 2nd and 3rd stitches of each row, you can either sew them with **MC** or leave them open because they are not very visible. You can also slip a matching color cord in there.

**K :** knit

**P :** purl

**SL :** slip

**St(s) :** stitch(es)

**Kf/b :** knit in the front and the back of the same st (increase)

**K2TOG :** knit 2 together (decrease)
