The pane will then be frozen into a 300 pound (136 kilograms) block of ice just like the one in the photo below and you will be an exciting part of Froid'Art!



The winners will have their awesome Froid'Art submissions displayed in our downtown courtyard at 203 B Wellington Street, Kingston Ontario, where they will stay until they melt! We get hundreds of visitors each week and your art will be seen by every one of them!

We love everything artful here at Martello Alley and we really love getting our youthful community involved in the arts.

The Rules

Our contest is open to two groups of students: junior students from K to grade 9 and senior students from grade 9 to 12/OAC.

Each submission must be on the entry form provided and must include the completed permission information from a legal guardian. (See below).

The art work must have a title.

The title must be referenced in any email correspondence to us.

The theme for your submission is "What I love about winter!" Maybe it's hockey, or snowball fights or a great toboggan run. We want you to create art about whatever you love about winter.

- 2) Design your artwork using the template provided. You may use your own sheet of paper and draw it in larger format, as long as the artwork scales to the same dimensions (height = 15" x width =32"). Note that your artwork must be in HORIZONTAL orientation.
- 3) Scan or take a picture of your artwork and upload to your or your parent or guardian's Facebook and/or Instagram account

- 5) Submit the information and authorization by email or in person to Martello Alley

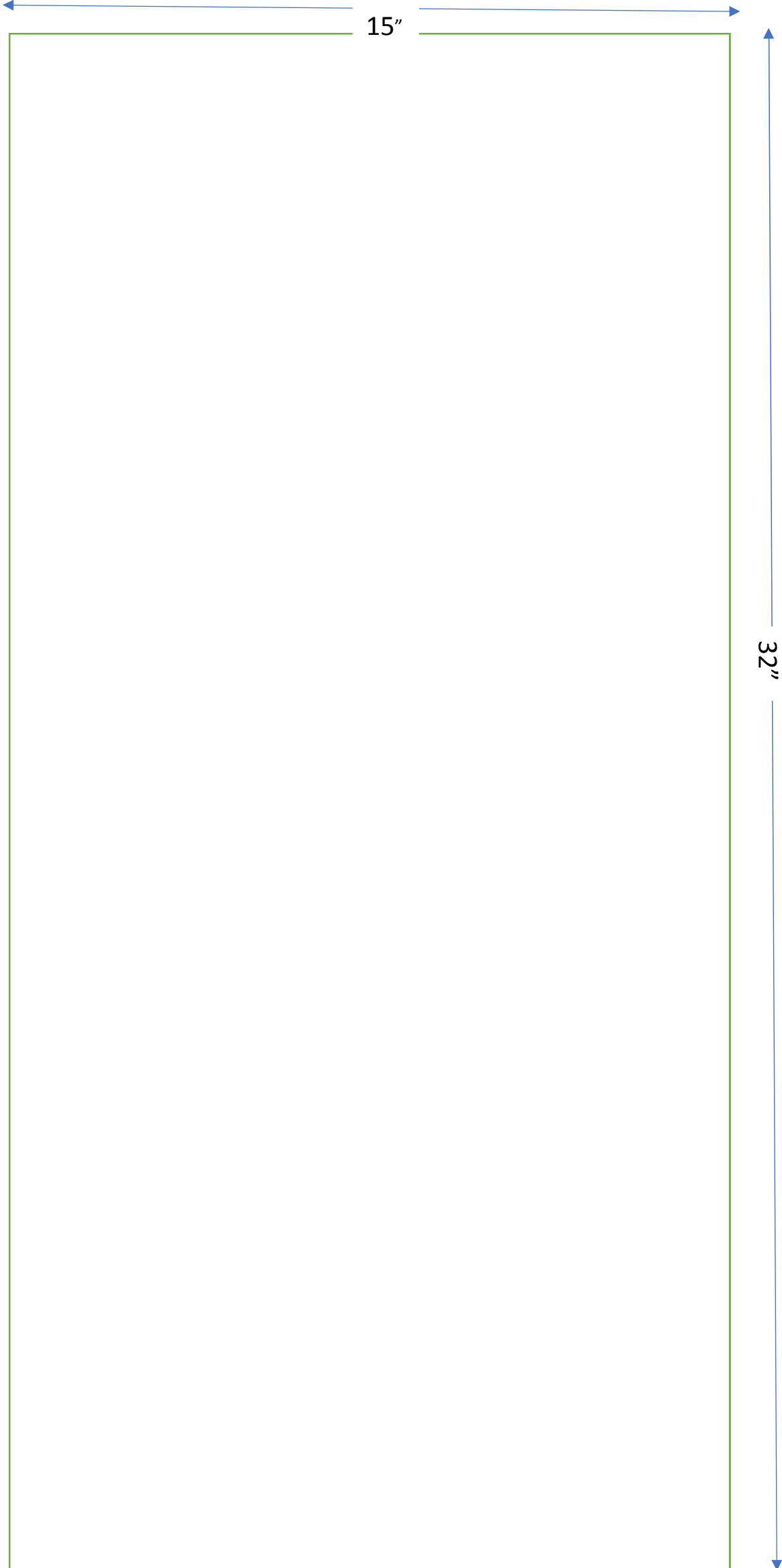
