## The Little Lower Layer;

or, the Supplementary Dick for Moby-Dick fetishists

**Warning:** This alternative mode is a nonstandard, unnatural, and quite possibly blasphemous way to play with your *Dick*. It requires a clinical-level obsession with *Moby-Dick* and is not compatible with normal human beings.

## OFFICIAL INSTRUCTIONS

The goal is to arrange the white cards in the order in which they appear in the book. It works with any number of players. To start, place any white card face up on the table.

When it's your turn, do as follows:

- (1) **Draw** a white card from the deck and place it in the Dick Holder so that you can see the text but not the chapter name and number. Or just cover up the chapter name and number with your thumb.
- (2) **Point** to where the card should go in the sequence of cards that have already been played.
- (3) Check the card to find out if you were right. If you were right, the card goes on the table in the right order. If you were wrong, you keep the card.

Play passes to the next player after each card.

If you want to keep score, players are "out" once they have accumulated five cards, i.e., once they have been wrong five times.

**N.B.:** We recommend considering the answer correct as long as it puts the chapters in the right order. If you want to get granular about whether "putting your hand into the tar-pot" falls before or after "a bloody battle in Affghanistan" in Chapter 1, you can search the text of *Moby-Dick* at *text.whysoever.com*.
