

Note: You will need 250L of beans to fill our fabric bean bag and 200L of beans to fill our leather bean bag. We also suggest asking a friend to help.



1 / Start by unfolding the calico liner.



2 / Unzip the calico liner half way.



3 / While one person holds the bag open, have the other person pour beans slowly into the bean bag liner.



4 / Pause throughout this process to zip the liner up and shuffle the beans to the base of the liner. Repeat where necessary.



5 / Once filled, zip up the liner.



6 / Now it's time to stuff! Place the bean bag cover on the floor with the zipper side facing up and open.



7 / Lay the bean bag liner over the outer in the same position.



8 / Feed the bottom two corners of the bean bag liner into the cover.



9 / Continue to feed the filled liner inside the bean bag.



10 / Feed the back and front corners into the bean bag cover.



11 / Zip up the bean bag.



12 / Flip over so the zipper is facing the ground.



13 / Sit down and enjoy!

Important:
Snap off the zipper pull from the liner using a pair of scissors (this is to ensure no small children can open the bean bag on their own)
