


TIME TO SIGN UP

You can check them out in the Wool Gathering Ravelry thread (listed below) or via their Facebook page for some inspiration. Both Knitters and Crocheters are welcome!

To participate, you need to choose a pattern/s from an Aussie or Kiwi Designer and knit/crochet it from an Aussie or NZ locally produced yarn or Indie Dyer. Simple! Then... begin your project and join in the chat on Ravelry and have some great fun.! The KAL begins on 1st February and finishes on the 15th March.

KNITTING SKILLS CLASS: "SOCKS"

3 classes from 10:00 -12:00pm Tuesday 27th February, 6th March & 13th March 2018

By popular demand our Sock Class with Canadian Kate is back! Come and learn how to make socks from the best Teacher ever. We have loads of amazing yarn to suit any sock you want to make.

Please note: This class is designed for Intermediate Knitters.

Class cost is \$90 which includes tuition, pattern and afternoon tea.

KNITTING SKILLS CLASS: "KNIT A BENTO BAG"

3 classes from 1-3pm Wednesday 7th, 21st March and 4th April 2018

This skills class will be run by Canadian Kate, so it is guaranteed you will have loads of fun! This class has been designed for both Beginner's and Intermediate knitters.

Over three weeks, you will discuss and choose the appropriate

yarn for the bag you want. Learn how to swatch and read your swatches properly to get the size you want for the bag. You will learn the magic of the Bento Bag fold and seaming. As each bag will be individual, the manner in which you seam your bag will vary. The last class will be based on the finishing touches, for e.g., Straps, Button closures, I-cord edgings, etc.

Beginner's can make the bag in a simple garter stitch and Intermediate knitters can make the bag in any stitch style of their choosing.

Class cost is \$90 which includes tuition, pattern and afternoon tea.

BEGINNER'S SMOCKING CLASS

Mondays from 1:00-3:00pm for 5 weeks From Monday 5th February to 12th March 2018 (Note: No classes on Monday Public Holiday)

If you haven't discovered how to smock, then you are missing out. Come and meet Pam and learn this beautiful and classic skill.

Dress patterns are available in this class for 12months, 18th months and 2 years of age sizes.

This class is designed for intermediate/experienced sewers as you will need to be able to sew the dress up after you have finished smocking.



Class cost is \$140 which includes tuition, pattern, a calico sampler for you to learn smocking stitches and afternoon tea.



SMOCKING CLUB

Wednesday morning's for 5 weeks, 09:45-12:00pm. From Wednesday 7th February to 7th March 2018

Quilting is an old and beautiful art. Come and learn the basics from the wonderful Elissa and learn how to construct a Strip quilt. Although simple in essence, a strip quilt is an amazing way to showcase your fabric.

Elissa will help you through your choice of fabrics, construction of the quilt itself, quilting the layers together and finally, putting the finishing touches in place.

Class cost is \$125 and includes tuition and morning tea.

"LONG TIME GONE" QUILT

Every second Tuesday 1:00-3:00pm 13th, 27th February, 13th, 27th March and 10th April 2018

The Long Time Gone Quilt has been designed by Jen Kingwell, one of the most talented Quiltmakers in Australia.

Each week in this class, Elissa will teach you how to construct the next block and you will learn new techniques for each block. This class is a Quiltalong class and get you started on this fabulous quilt..

Class cost is \$100 for 4 classes which includes tuition and afternoon tea

SUSTAINABLE QUILTING

Evening Class, From 5:30pm - 8:00pm Monday 19th & 26th February 2018

The word sustainable has so many different meanings, but to us, it means re-using and giving new purpose for old fabric where its current use is no longer meaningful or where the fabric is worn out and ripped. There are plenty of opportunities to give new purpose to treasured old garments, pillow cases or Op Shop wonders. Sustaining the fabric by unpicking it in its current form, washing it with care and love, giving it a new life and creating a quilt to keep someone warm is a wonderful process.

You can choose to either hand stitch or use a machine to construct your quilt. The choice is yours. The first night we will discuss fabrics and pattern choices and we will provide suggestions and inspiration for you. If you have a special quilt pattern you wish to use, bring it down! What to bring:

- *A selection of your clean fabrics/garments/treasures ready to be cut.
- *Scissors, Cutter, quilting mat, rulers, Needles, Threads, etc.

You will need to start now to source your fabrics for your new quilt. 100% Cotton or Linen's are the types of fabric you will need to use. They will need to be washed and clean ready for their new life. If you love fabric, texture and creating something very different, then come to this very different class. Come and share some inspiration.

Class cost is \$60 for 2 classes and includes light nibbles and tea/coffee.
