**The quick essentials:**

**- What is it?**

A great opportunity to taste loads of wines, eat super tasty food, all in great company with great music and plenty of activities focused around food and wine.

**- How much does it cost?**

£7 (+ the eventbrite fee) - That part helps towards the cost of the venue hire as well as participates towards paying our lovely staff a fair living wage.

Tokens will be used to redeem against wine and drinks on the night. We are currently looking at £10 for 11 tokens and £20 for 24 tokens. Wines will be typically priced between 1 to 5 tokens for a 50ml measure. We feel this is a good way of keeping the costs to you as low as possible whilst enabling you to try as many wines as possible.

There will be the possibility of doubling up to 100ml if you want more than a sampling measure.

There will also be a refundable £2 glass deposit. You are welcome to keep your unique glass at the end of the night or get your £2 back.

## FAQs

### **Are there ID or minimum age requirements to enter the event?**

This event is aimed at people over 18 years of age however littl'uns are welcome under the supervision of their parents/guardians. There will be food, soft drinks and board games available to enjoy in a safe environment.

### **What are my transport/parking options for getting to and from the event?**

We recommend you use public transport and/or taxis to get to and from the venue, which is located only a short walk away from Piccadilly train station. There is on street parking in the surrounding area but we will not take any responsibility for damages to your vehicles.

### **What can I bring into the event?**

Other than that, we will not accept food or drink from outside the venue and you accept that your bags may be checked on entrance. (Exceptions will be made for the youngsters' snacks and drinks).

### **Do I have to bring my printed ticket to the event?**

We will be able to scan your ticket's QR code from your mobile phone so please avoid printing your tickets if it's not necessary.

The tickets gives you access to the venue and participates towards the cost of using the venue and paying the lovely people who will help make your evening a memorable one a fair living wage. You will need to purchase tokens in order to redeem them against drinks throughout the evening. A refundable glass-deposit (£2) will also be required. Food from the vendors is not included and you will need cash to deal with the vendors direct however, they are now often able to take card payments too.
