

INFUSING COCONUT OIL

INGREDIENTS

- 1 ounce cannabis flower
- 2 cups coconut oil

STEPS

Note: The recipe calls for a 2:1 ratio of oil to flower. You can go smaller and do a ½ ounce of flower with 1 cup of coconut oil, for example.

1. Grind the flower with an herb grinder.
2. Remove any seeds or stems.
3. Place flower in the Butter Brewer
4. Use the “DIY” setting. Set temperature to 225F, time to 1 hour, mix duration to 1 minute, and mix interval to 5 minutes. The mixing paddles ensures that the flower is heated evenly during decarboxylation.
5. Remove the pan from the Butter Brewer and let the herb sit until cool. You can place in the refrigerator to speed up the process. Make sure to use oven mits when handling the pan, as it gets hot during decarboxylation.
6. Add the oil to the pan.
7. Press the “OIL” preset button.
8. When the machine is finished, lift the lid and allow to cool 3-5 minutes
9. Use the included strainer bag to strain the flower out of the oil by placing the bag in a larger bowl or jar and pouring the contents of the pan through the straining bag. Use tongs or your hands to squeeze the flower in the bag – you’ll typically get another ¼ to ½ cup of oil by squeezing the remaining oil out of the flower.



That's it! Now you can use this oil in various recipes, as called for.
