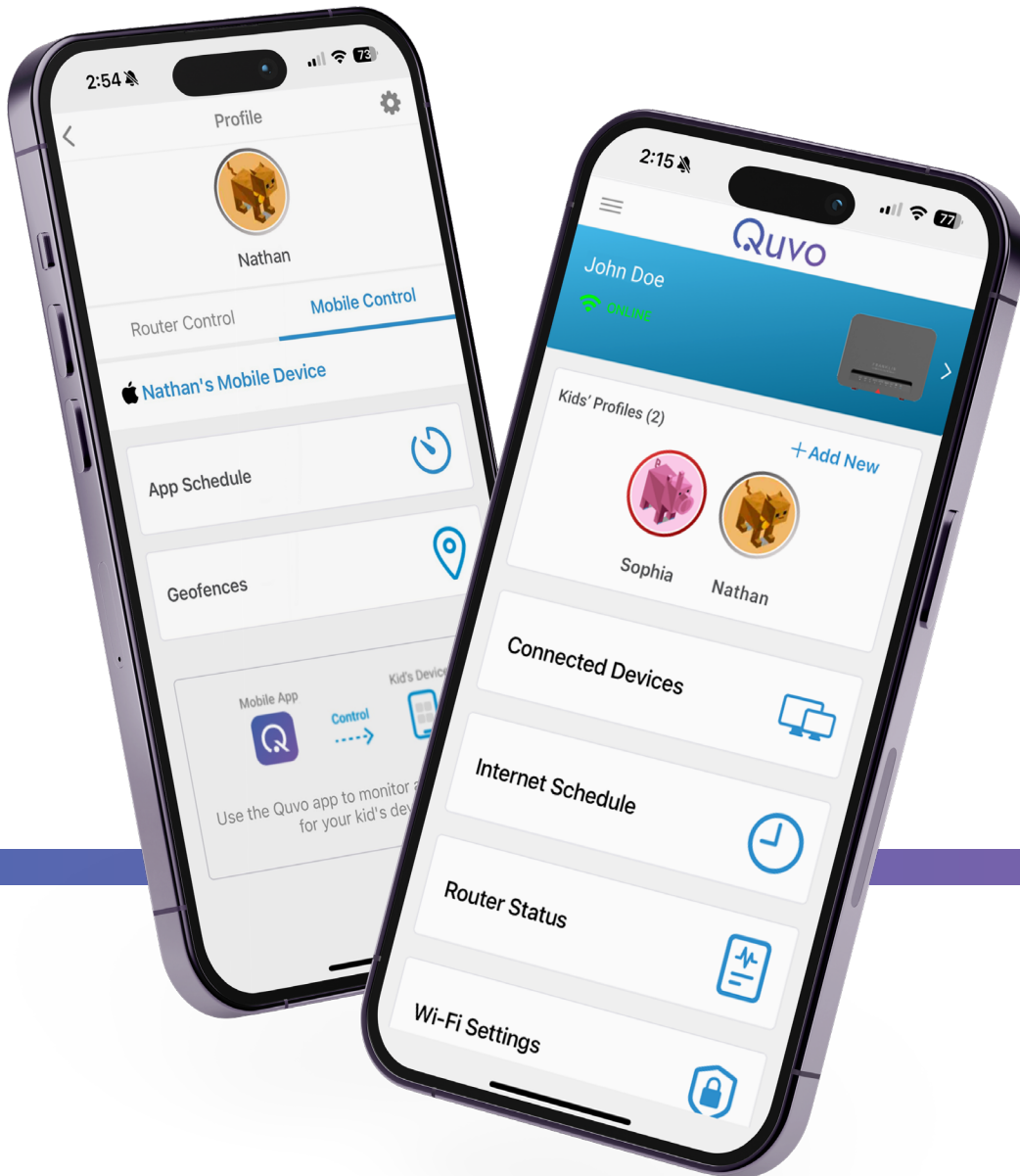

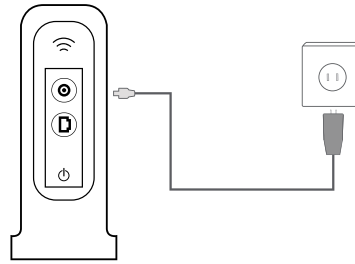

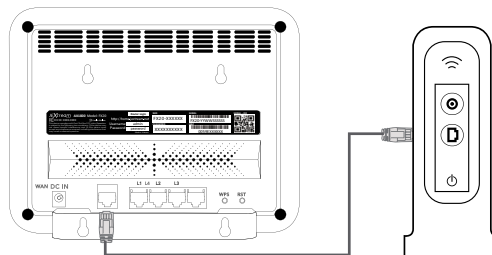
# Initial Setup

## A. Device Setup

1. Unplug or power off your home modem.

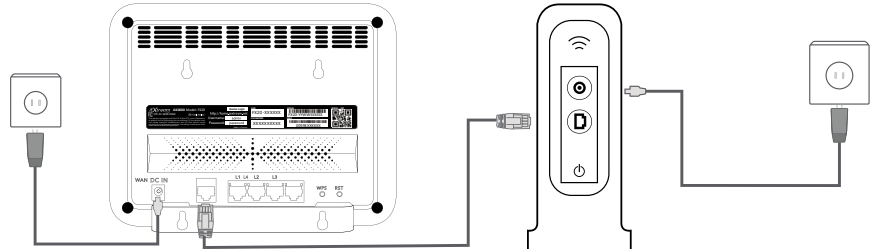


2. Connect the Quvo router to your modem via Ethernet cable.



3. Connect the power to the modem and the Quvo router.

*\*The Power LED light will display a solid amber color when the router is powered on.*

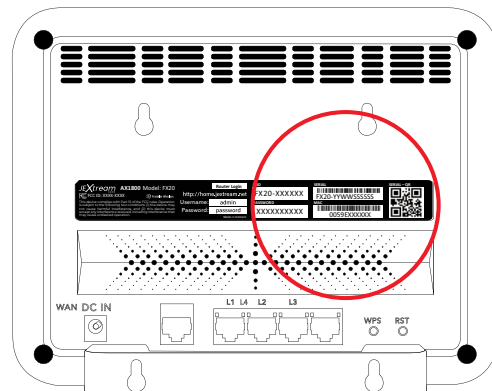


4. Optional: Connect a computer via an Ethernet cable.

5. Connect to Wi-Fi, find the SSID and password on the back of the router, or scan the QR code.

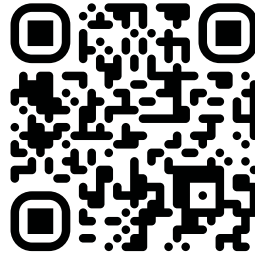
6. Optional: visit <http://192.168.10.1> to access the router web interface for detailed router configuration.

*In login window, enter "password" as the password.*

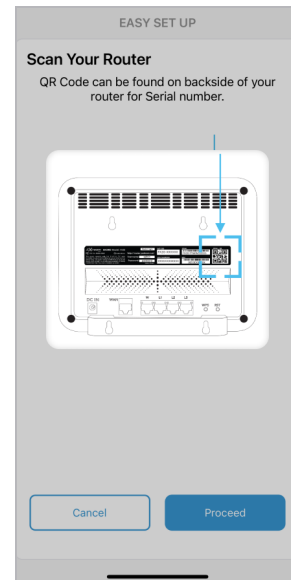
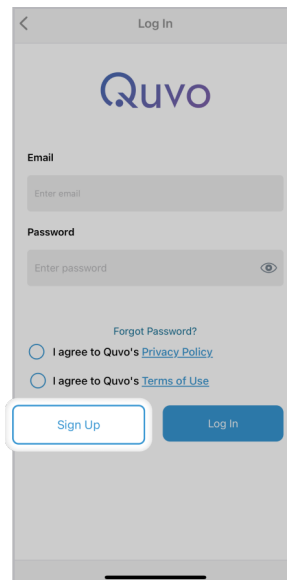


## B. App Installation & Device Registration

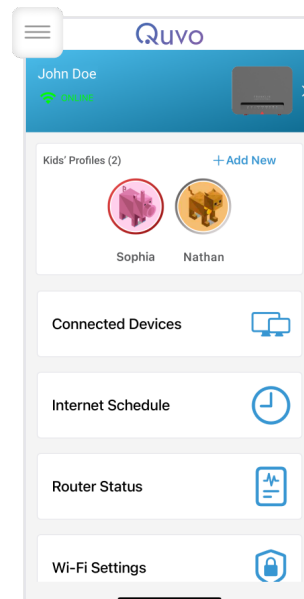
1. Scan the QR code on the right or visit **quvostore.com** on your mobile device to install the Quvo app.



2. Launch the Quvo app and sign up with your email. Scan the QR code on the back of the router to complete the sign-up.



3. Control your router remotely, limit daily usage, and filter content for your kids. See tutorials in the main menu (≡) for more details.



# How to Use the App

## A. Home Overview

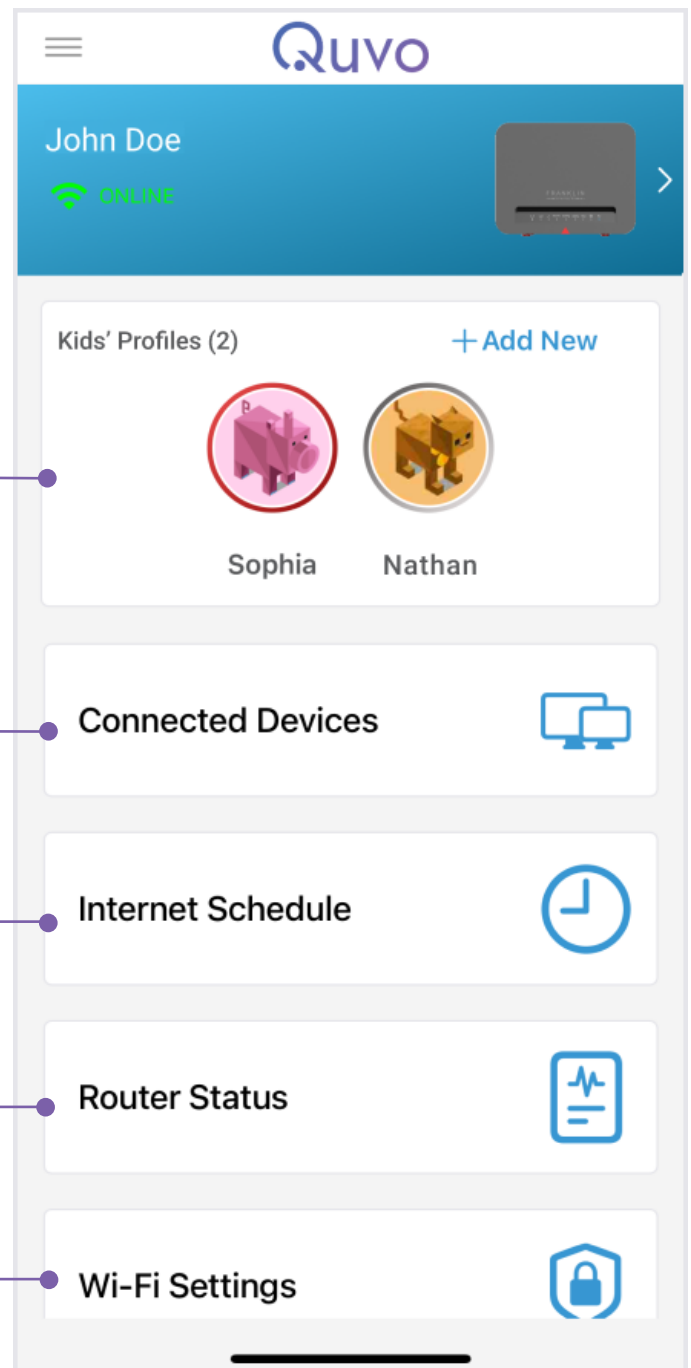
**Profiles** - Create profiles and easily manage your kids' devices with a single parental policy.

**Connection Devices** - View devices that are connected to your home network.

**Internet Schedule** - Add, view, or edit schedules that block internet access.

**Router Status** - View your network's CPU usage, Memory usage, WAN/LAN connections.

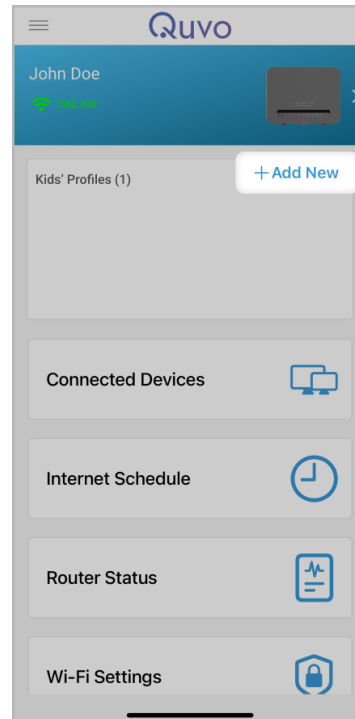
**Wi-Fi Settings** - View or edit your Wi-Fi's name and password.



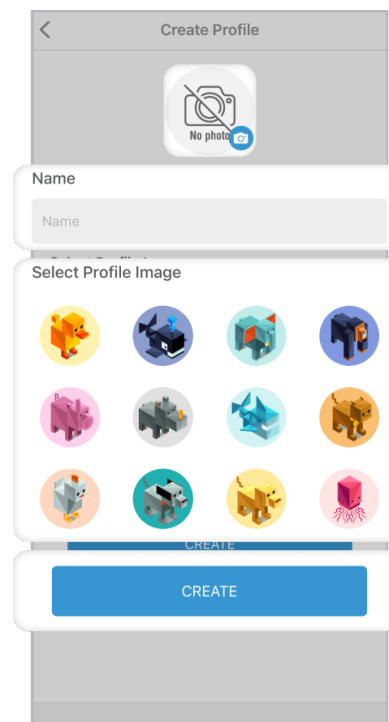
## B. Setup on Parent's Device

### Create a Kid's Profile

1. From Home, tap "Add New" button in the "Kids' Profiles" section.

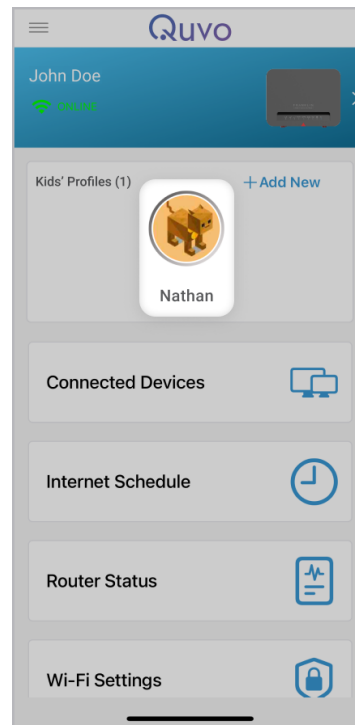


2. Enter the kid's name, set the profile image, and tap the "Create" button.

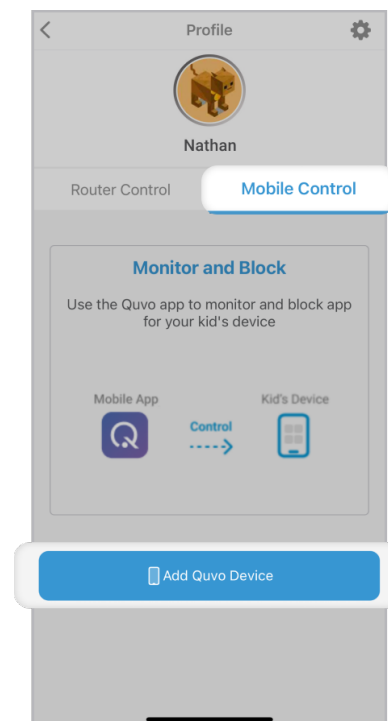


## Pair Mobile Devices

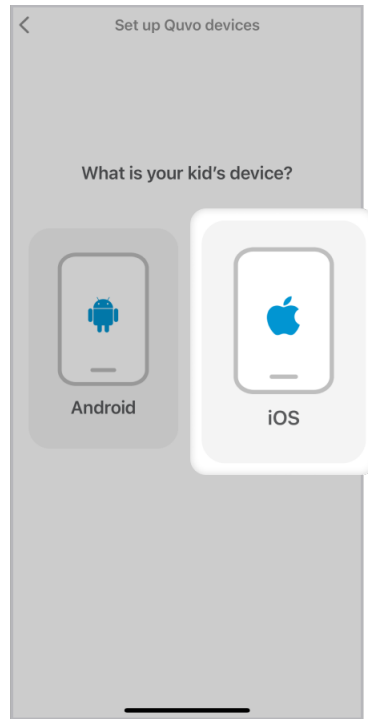
1. From Home, select a profile from “Kids’ Profiles.”



2. Go to the “Mobile Control” tab and tap “Add Quvo Device”

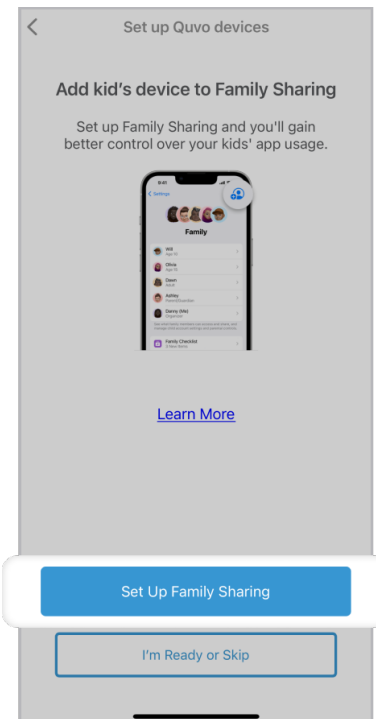


3. Select “iOS” as your kid’s device type.



4. Optional: Tap “Set Up Family Sharing” to enable family sharing among iOS devices

*\*Note: “Family Sharing” is only available if the parent’s device is also iOS*





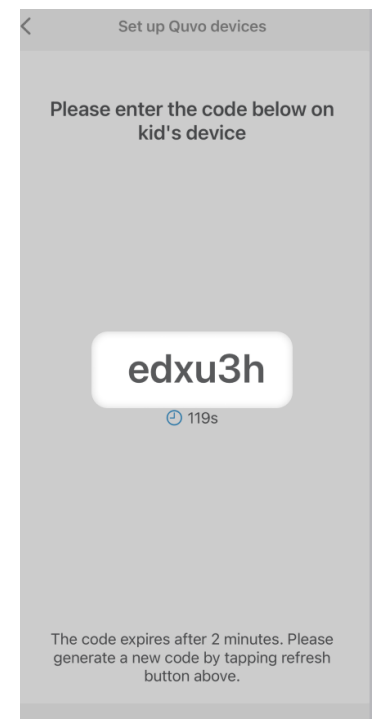
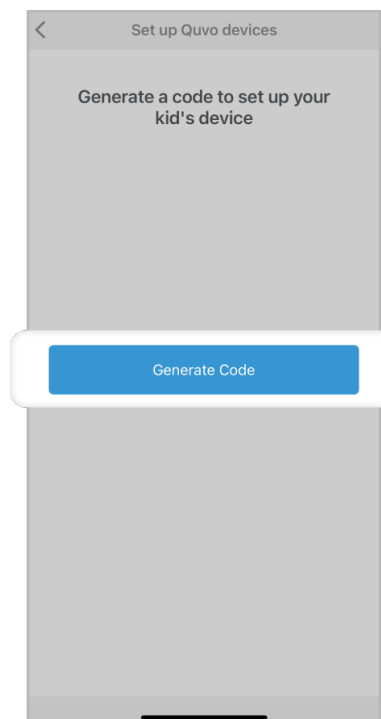
5. Scan the QR code and install the Quvo app on the kid's device.



6. Tap "Generate Code"

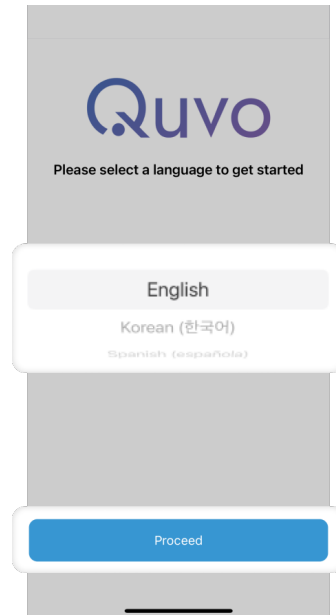
7. Follow the prompts on the kid's device and enter the code generated on the parent's device when prompted.

*\*Note: "Family Sharing" is only available if the parent's device is also iOS*

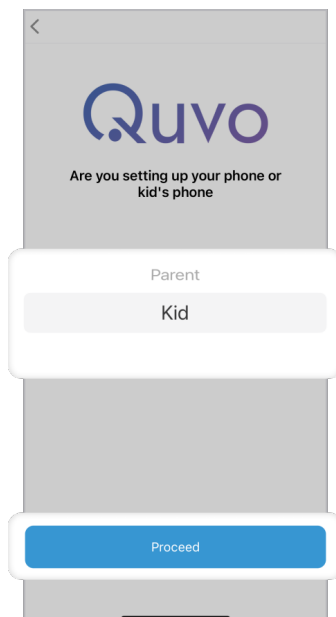


## C. Setup on Kid's Device


1. Launch the Quvo app, select a language to get started, and tap "Proceed."



2. Select "Kid" when asked to specify whose device you are setting up.



3. Enter the kids' name.
4. Review and agree to the privacy policy and terms of use to proceed.



5. Enter the code generated from the parent's device and tap "Proceed."

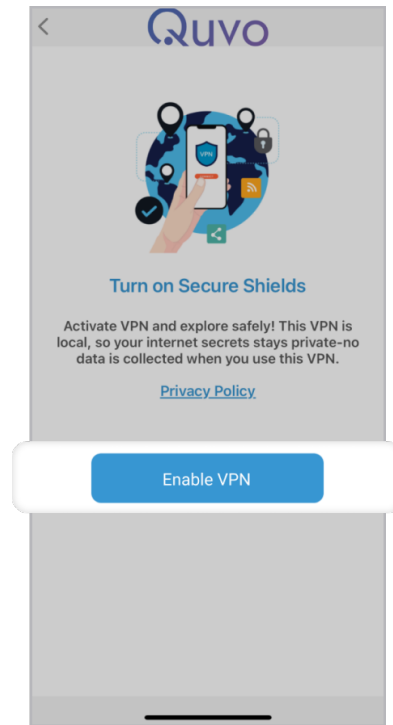

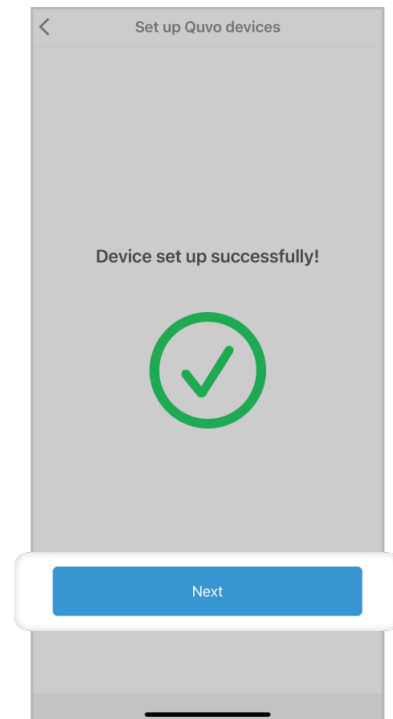

6. Tap “Enable VPN.”



7. Go to the parent's device, and tap “Next” when “Device Setup Successfully” is shown on the screen.

*\*Note: Refer to Section E > “Geofence”*

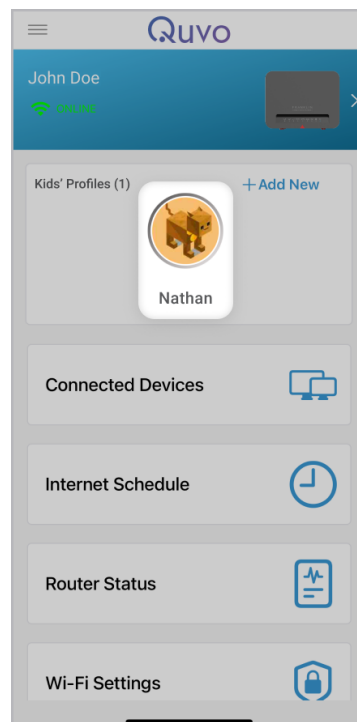


## D. Router Control: Content Filter, Browsing History & Assigned Schedules

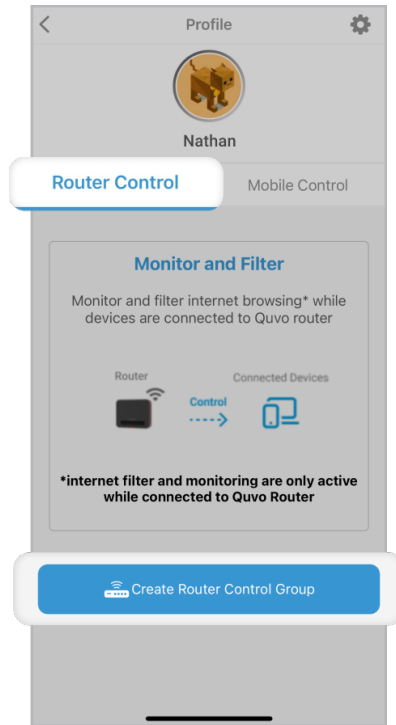
“Router Control” allows you to monitor and filter internet activity while devices are connected to the Quvo router.

### Create Router Control Group

1. From Home, select a profile from “Kids’ Profiles.”



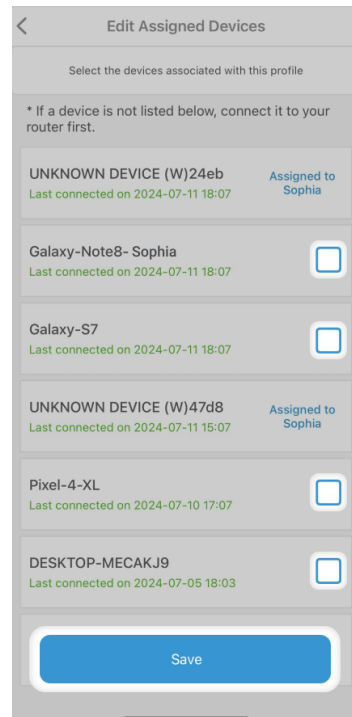
2. Go to the “Router Control” tab and tap “Create Router Control Group.”




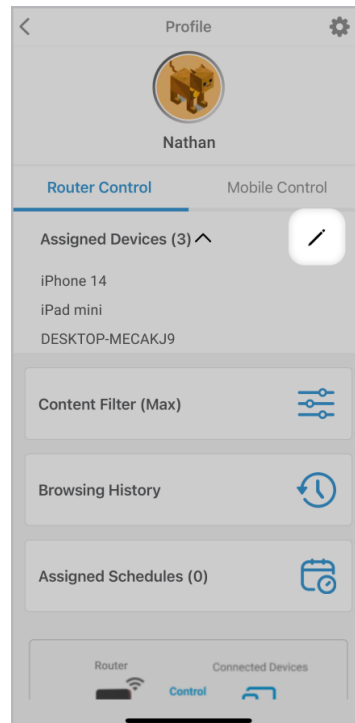
3. Select the devices you wish to assign to the profile.

*\*Note: If a device is not listed, connect the device to your Quvo router first.*

4. Tap “Save.”

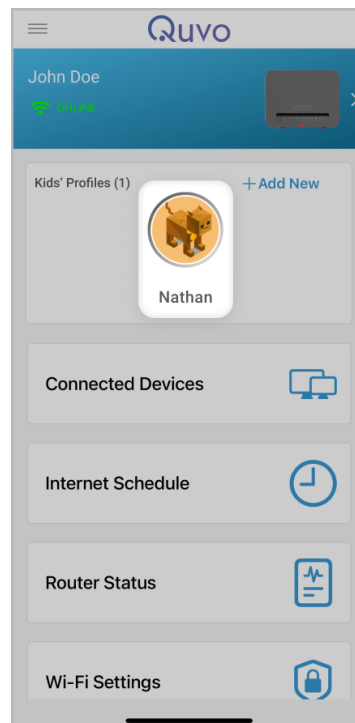


5. To manage assigned devices after the initial setup, tap the  button next to "Assigned Devices." Repeat step 3 and 4.

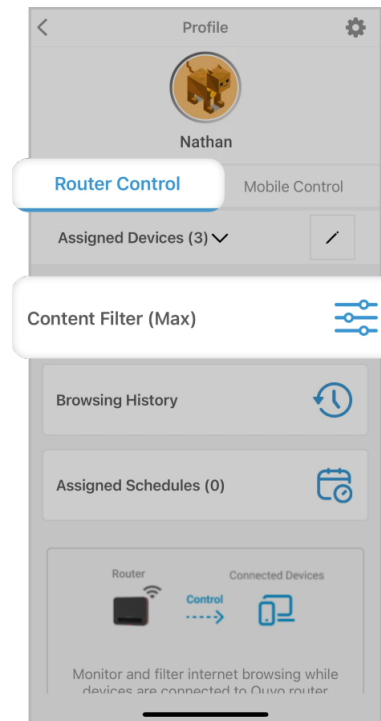


## Content Filter

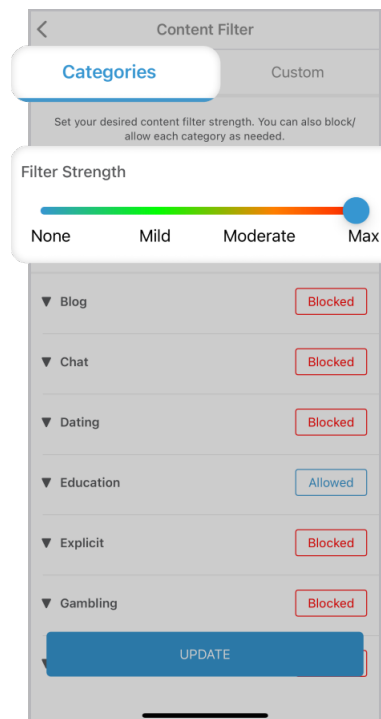
1. From Home, select a profile from "Kids' Profiles."



2. Go to the “Router Control” tab and tap “Content Filter.”

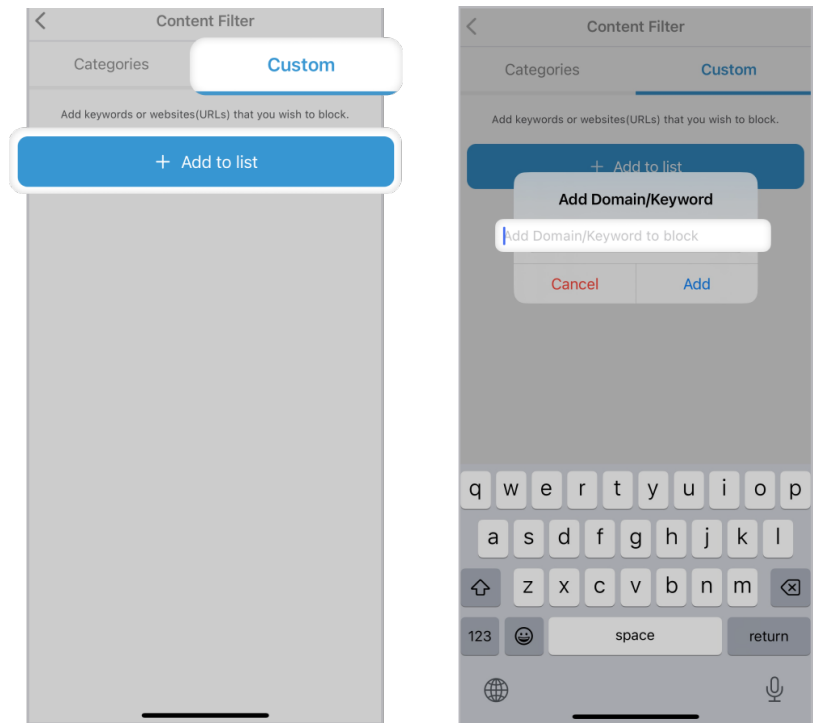


3. Set the desired filtering strength in the “Categories” tab.



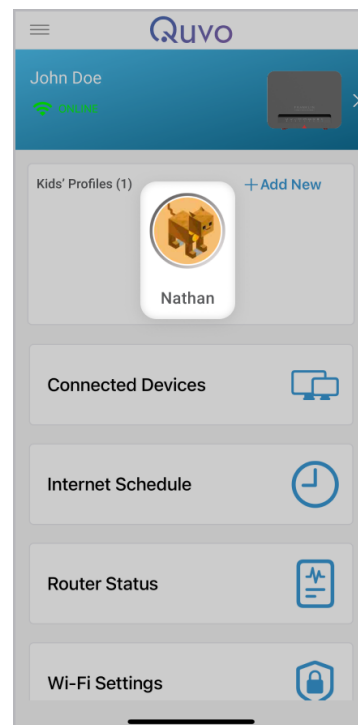


4. Add custom filtering in the “Custom” tab by entering specific keywords or website URLs you wish to block.

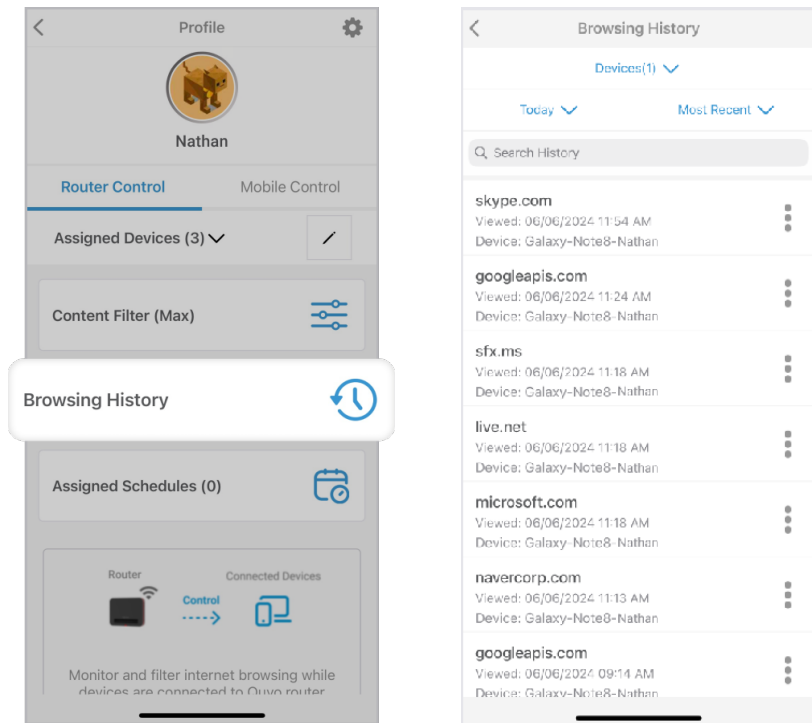


## Browsing History

1. From Home, select a profile from “Kids’ Profiles.”

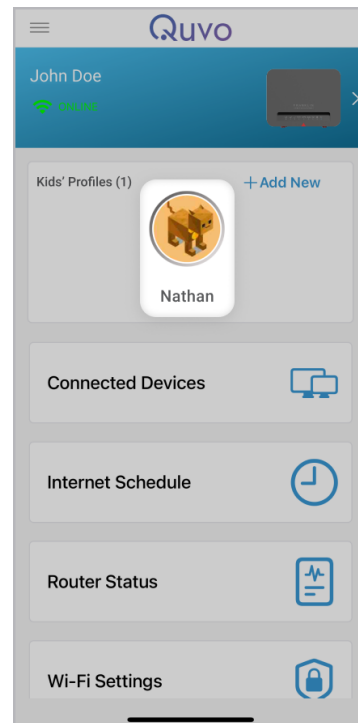


2. Go to the “Router Control” tab and tap “Browsing History” to view the kid’s browsing data.

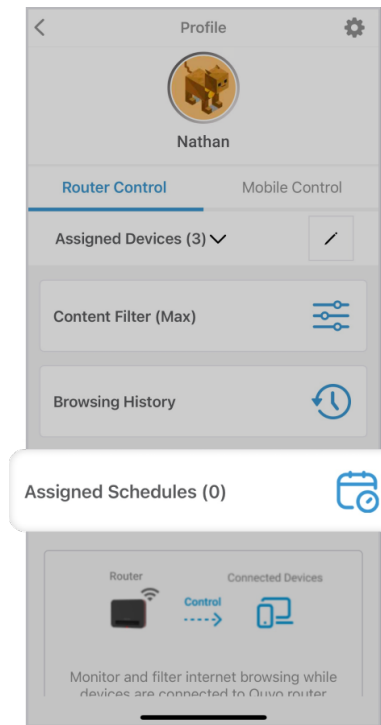



## Assigned Schedules

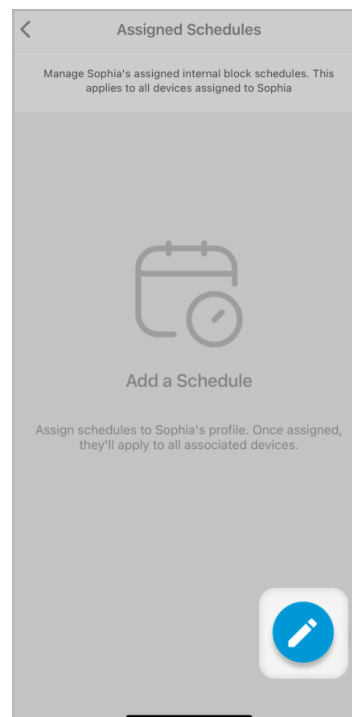
1. From Home, select a profile from “Kids’ Profiles.”



2. Go to the “Router Control” tab and tap “Assigned Schedules.”



3. Tap the  button on the bottom right to assign a new schedule.

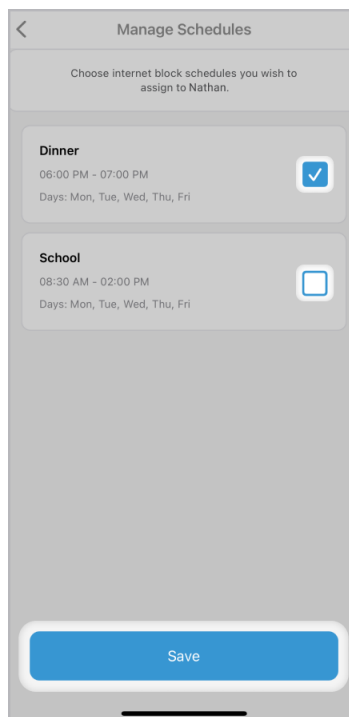


4. Select schedules to assign from the list of schedules.

*\*Note: Refer to Section F > “Internet Schedule” to create a new schedule(s).*

5. Tap “Save.”

*\*Note: Schedules apply to all devices assigned to the profile.*



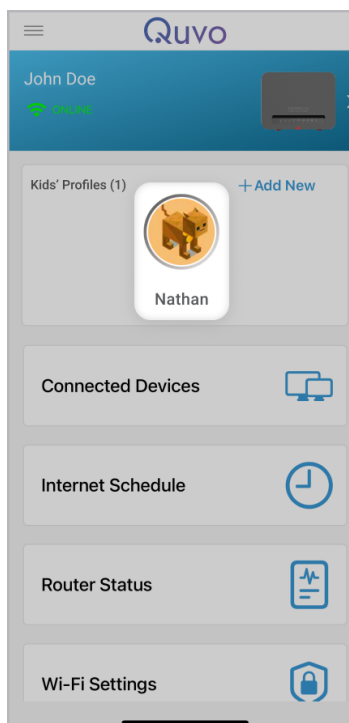
## E. Mobile Control: App Schedules & Geofence

“Mobile Control” allows you to monitor and block your kid’s app usage using the Quvo Solutions app on their device.

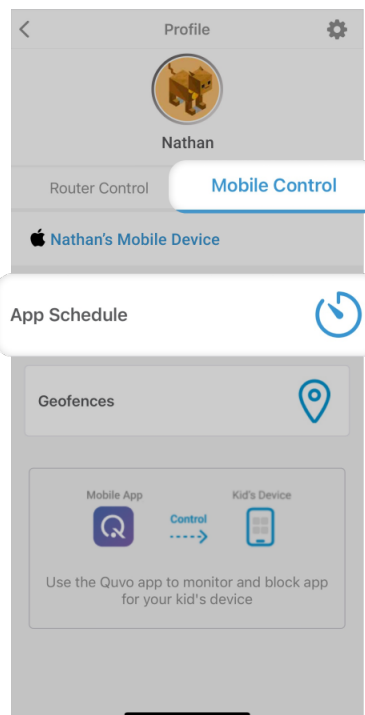
*\*Note: Ensure you’ve set up the kid’s device to activate the features. Refer to Section A> “<Setup on Kid’s Device>.”*


### App Schedules

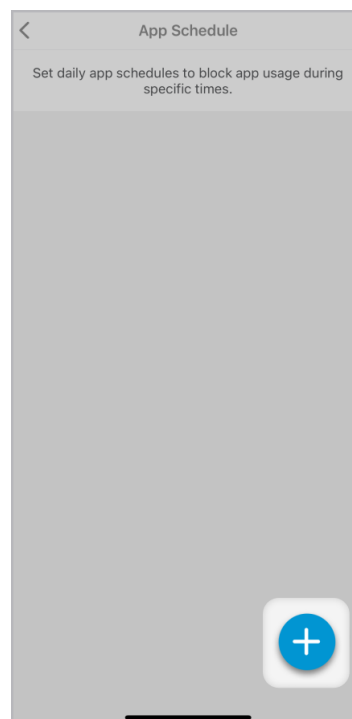
1. From Home, select a profile from “Kids’ Profiles.”



2. Go to the “Mobile Control” tab and tap “App Schedule.”

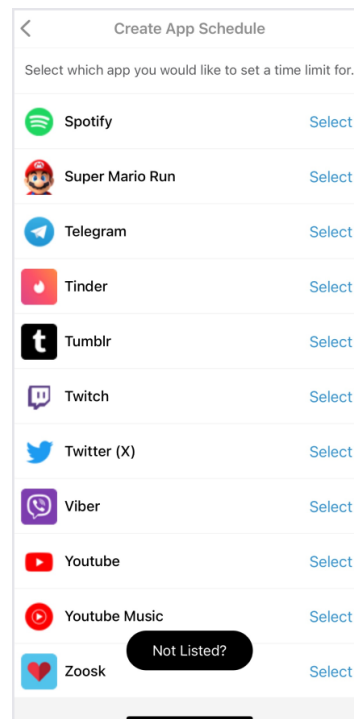


3. Tap the  button on the bottom right of the screen to add an app you want to set schedules for.



#### 4. Select an app from the list.

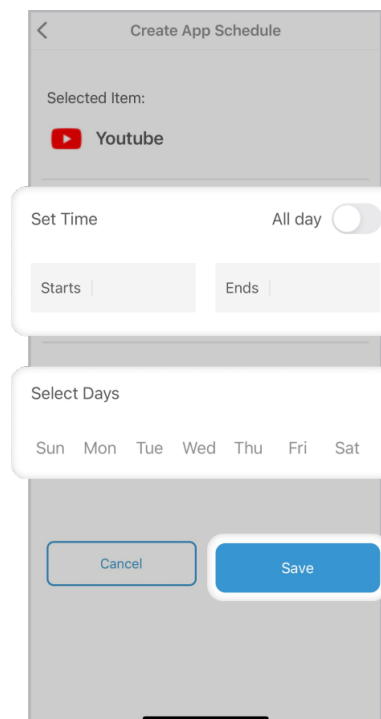
*\*Note: If the parent's device is also iOS, apps not listed can still be managed. After adding your kid to your Family Sharing, tap the "Not Listed?" button and select the apps you wish to schedule. [Learn more About Family Sharing.](#)*



#### 5. Set the desired time limit.

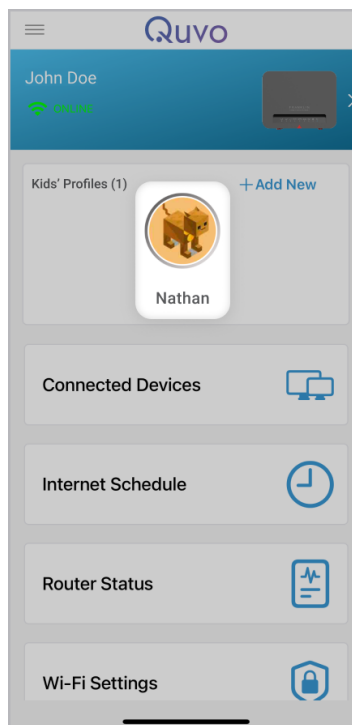
#### 6. Select the days these limits will apply.

#### 7. Tap "Save."

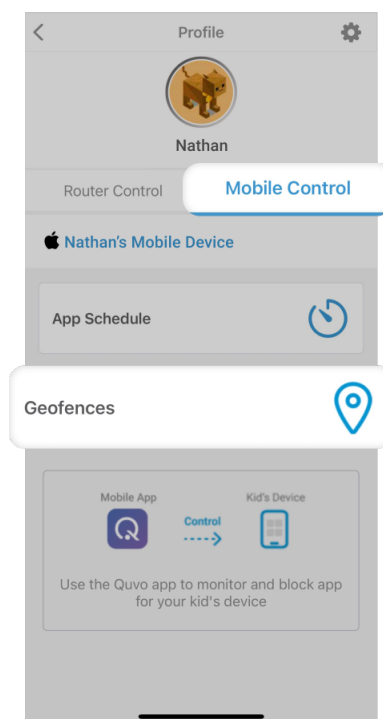



## Geofence

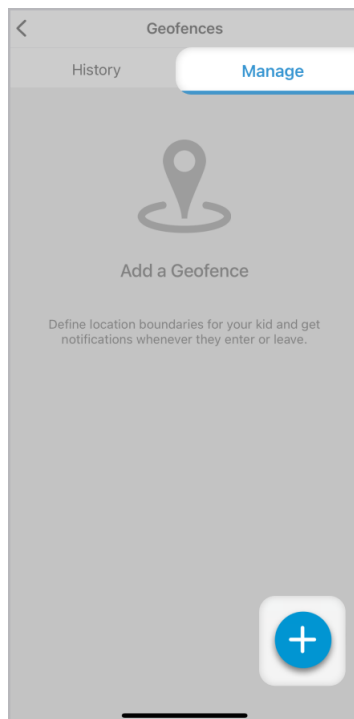
1. From Home, select a profile from “Kids’ Profiles.”



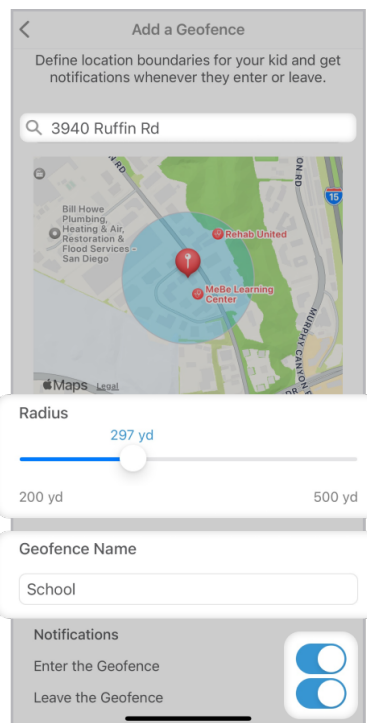
2. Go to the “Mobile Control” tab and tap “Geofences.”



3. In the “Manage” tab, tap the  button on the bottom right of the screen to add geofencing parameters.



4. Enter location.
5. Set radius.
6. Name the geofence.
7. Set whether you want to be notified when your kid enters or leaves the geofence.

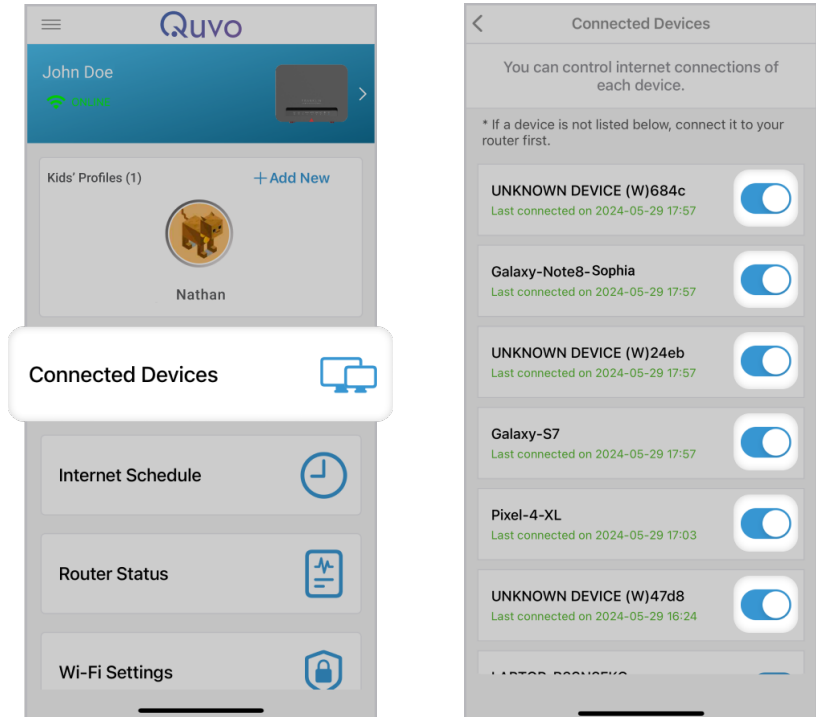




## F. General Router Settings & Information

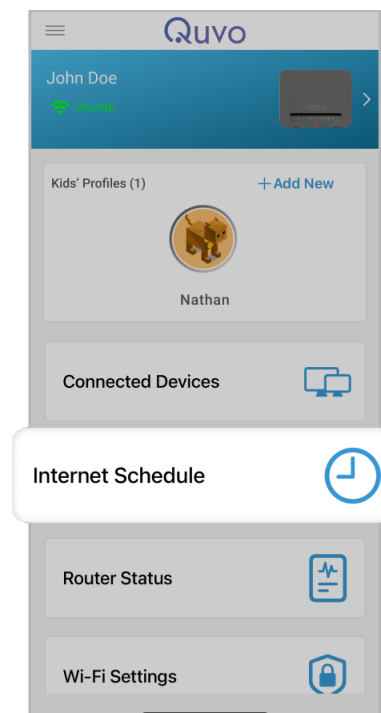
### Connected Devices


1. From Home, tap “Connected Devices.”
2. View and manage all devices connected to the router.

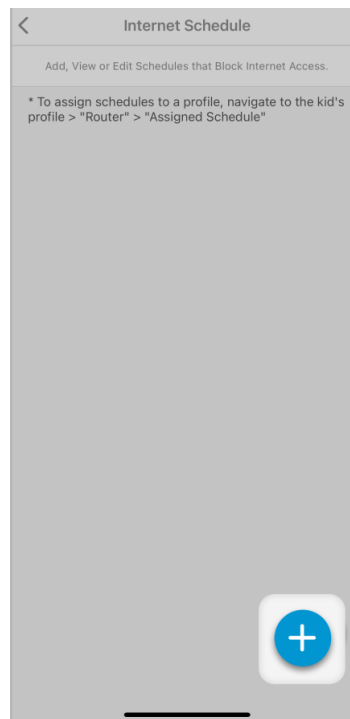


### Internet Schedule

1. From Home, tap “Internet Schedule.”



2. Tap the  button on the bottom right of the screen to add a new schedule.

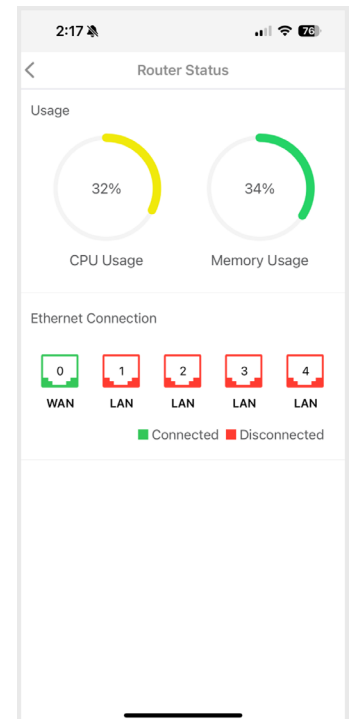
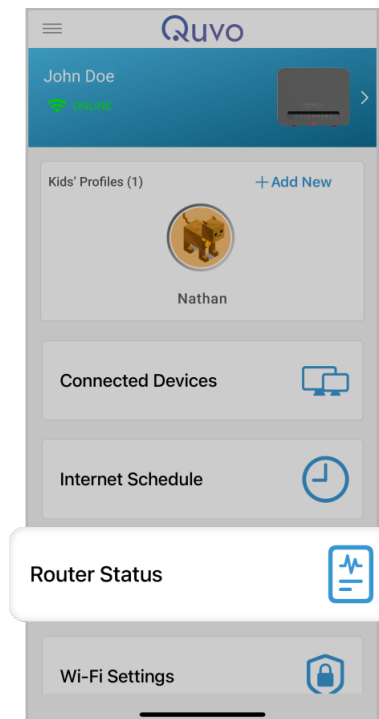


3. Add a title.
4. Set start time and end time.
5. Select days for the internet schedule.
6. Tap "Create."

*\*Note: Refer to Section B > "Assign Schedules" to assign schedules to a profile.*

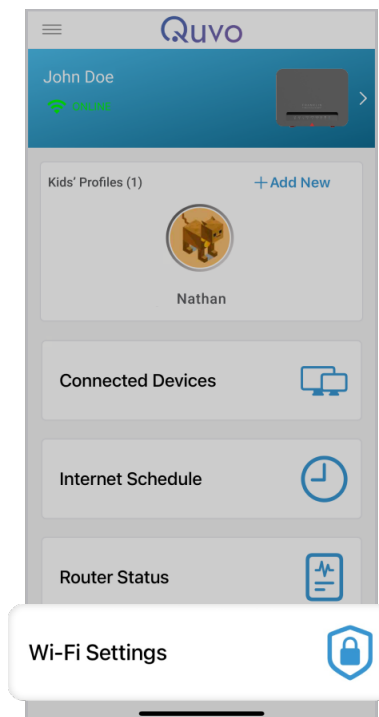
## Router Status

1. From Home, tap “Router Status” to view router analytics like CPU usage, memory, and Ethernet connections.



## Wi-Fi Settings

1. From Home, tap “Wi-Fi Settings.”
2. Name networks and set passwords.
3. Enable/Disable VPN passthrough as needed.
4. Tap “Save & Restart Device” to save changes.
