The Midwest Implant Institute graduation requirements include:

- Explain to patient functionality of implant, abutment, and crown, and the entire implant process
- Treatment plan basic implant procedures from start to finish
- Successfully review medical history for each surgery patient and analyze what that means for surgery
- Master 6 handed dentistry
- Identify instruments used in surgical procedures
- Properly set up a half drape surgery (Solo)
- Review post-op instructions with surgery patients (Solo)
- Execute pre and post surgical surgery documents
- Complete and document surgical notes in software (Solo)
- Adapt any prosthetics work post operatively
- Surgical photography to document all Extern surgeries
