The MII Externship Surgical Requirements:

The Complete Externship Program (CEP) embodies the complete surgical and didactic work at the Midwest Implant Institute®. Affiliation of this program allows the doctor-extern to complete as many surgical procedures as the extern doctor would prefer in their live training until their graduation date.

The description below provides the course and procedure requirements to complete the CEP. Although the doctor-extern must successfully place 14 implants for graduation, the average placement in the program is 25-40 implant placements.

	Two (2) mandibular posterior single implant
	One (1) Four-on-the-floor bar/overdenture patient
