California Consumer Privacy Statement

This California Privacy Statement supplements the general <u>Privacy Policy</u> of Red Diamond, Inc. as well as any of its affiliates or subsidiaries (collectively "Red Diamond"), and provides notices, disclosures and descriptions of rights under: (a) the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA"); (b) California's "Shine the Light" law; and (c) the California Online Privacy Protection Act.

I. <u>CCPA Privacy Notice</u>

This CCPA portion of the California Privacy statement applies solely to California consumers ("you") and addresses personal information we collect online and offline. This Statement does not apply to Red Diamond personnel or information collected about B2B personnel. Further, sections 2 and 3 of this privacy notice do not apply to job applicants.

Any terms in this statement undefined in this CCPA Privacy Statement or our General Privacy Policy have the meanings given to them in the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 and its implementing regulations, as they may be amended from time to time (the "CCPA").

1. Notice of Collection and Use of Personal Information

We may collect the following categories of personal information about you:

- Identifiers: identifiers such as real name, alias, postal address, unique personal identifiers (such as a device identifiers; cookies, beacons, pixel tags, mobile ad identifiers and similar technology; customer number, unique pseudonym, or user alias; telephone number and other forms of persistent or probabilistic identifiers), online identifiers, internet protocol address ("IP address"), email address, account name, social security number, drivers' license number, passport number, and other similar identifiers
- Additional Data Subject to Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.80: signature, physical characteristics or description, state identification card number, insurance policy number, education, bank account number, credit card number, debit card number, and other financial information, medical information, and health insurance information
- **Protected Classification:** characteristics of protected classification under California or federal law, such as race, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, marital status, medical condition, ancestry, genetic, information, disability, citizenship status, and military and veteran status
- **Commercial Information:** commercial information, including records of personal property, products or services purchased, obtained, or considered, and other purchasing or consuming histories or tendencies

- **Online Activity:** Internet and other electronic network activity information, including, but not limited to, browsing history, search history, and information regarding your interaction with websites, applications or advertisements
- Sensory Information: audio, electric, visual and similar information
- Employment Information: professional or employment-related information
- Education Information: educational information that is not publicly available personally identifiable information as defined in the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. Sec. 1232g; 34 C.F.R. Part 99)

We may use the categories of personal information listed above for the purposes described in our Privacy Notice. In addition, we may use these categories of personal information for certain business purposes specified in the CCPA, as described in this table:

3. California Consumer Privacy Rights.

You have certain choices and rights regarding your personal information, as described below.

<u>Access</u>: You have the right to request, twice in a 12-month period, that we disclose to you the personal information we have collected, used, disclosed, and sold about you during the past 12 months.

<u>Deletion</u>: You have the right to request that we delete certain personal information we have collected from you.

Verifying Requests. To help protect your privacy and maintain security, we will take steps to verify your identity before granting you access to your personal information or complying with your request. If you request access to or deletion of your personal information, we may require you to provide certain information, including: (a) name, (b) postal address, (c) email address and (d) telephone number. In addition, if you ask us to provide you with specific pieces of person information, we will require you to sign a declaration under penalty or perjury that you are the consumer whose personal information is the subject of the request.

Using an Authorized Agent. If you designate an authorized agent to make an access or deletion request on your behalf: (a) we may require you to provide the authorized agent written permission to do so, and (b) for access and deletion request, we may require you to verity your own identity directly with us.

Additional Information. If you choose to exercise any of your rights under the CCPA, you have the right to not receive discriminatory treatment by us. To the extent permitted by applicable law, we may charge a reasonable fee to comply with your request. This Statement is available in alternative formats upon request. II. <u>California's Shine the Light Law</u>

Separate from the CCPA, California's "Shine the Light" law gives California residents the right to ask companies what personal information they share with third parties for those third parties' direct marketing purposes. We do not disclose your personal information to third parties for the purpose of directly marketing their goods or services to you unless you request such disclosure. III. <u>California Online Privacy Protection Act ("CalOPPA")</u>

CalOPPA is the first state law in the nation to require commercial websites and online services to post a privacy policy.
