Essential Oil Spray Recipes



Basic Directions: Pick recipe from below & add essential oils to 2 oz glass spray bottle, add 1 tablespoon grain alcohol (like Everclear), fill rest of bottle with distilled water & place on top, shake to mix. Shake before each use.

Clean Linen Spray

8 drops Lavender 8 drops Grapefruit 4 drops Tea Tree ~Spritz onto linen, allow to air dry.

Sleepy Time Pillow Mist

15 drops Lavender 5 drops Roman Chamomile ~Lightly mist on pillow 10 minutes before bedtime.

Refreshing Room Spray

8 drops Eucalyptus 8 drops Orange 4 drops Lavender ~Mist into air to refresh any room.

Mood Mist Aroma Spray

10 drops Roman Chamomile 6 drops Orange 4 drops Ylang Ylang ~Mist into air when you need uplifting.

Spiced Cider Room Spray

8 drops Orange 6 drops Cinnamon 6 drops Ginger ~Spray into room or office to scent the air.

Citrus Burst Aroma Mist

4 drops Lemon
4 drops Orange
4 drops Bergamot
4 drops Tangerine
4 drops Grapefruit
~Mist into air & enjoy.

Citrus Forest Air Freshener

5 drops White Fir 5 drops Orange 5 drops Lemon 5 drops Bergamot ~Spritz in room to transform the space.

Calm Me Down Aroma Mist

10 drops Lavender 5 drops Bergamot 5 drops Frankincense ~Mist into air to create a calming space.

Ignite Your Passion Mist

6 drops Geranium
6 drops Orange
4 drops Clove
4 drops Ylang Ylang
~Spray in room to set
the mood.

Owie Spray

5 drops Myrrh
5 drops Frankincense
5 drops Lavender
5 drops Helichrysum
~Use alcohol free
witch hazel instead of
water, lightly spray on
cut or sore, air dry.

#2 Toilet Spray

5 drops Bergamot 5 drops Eucalyptus 5 drops Grapefruit 5 drops Lemongrass ~Spritz #2 spray into toilet bowl before going to get rid of odor.

Yoga Mat Cleaning Spray

12 drops Tea Tree 8 drops Lavender ~Use witch hazel instead of water. Spray yoga mat, wipe clean & let air dry.

Man Cave Room Spray

7 drops Bergamot 7 drops Cypress 6 drops Cedarwood ~Spray in room to transform the space.

Fresh Floral Air Freshener

10 drops Lavender
6 drops Geranium
4 drops Roman
Chamomile
~Spray in air to
freshen up any room

Itch Be Gone Spray

5 drops Lavender 5 drops Frankincense 5 drops Tea Tree ~Use alcohol free witch hazel instead of water. Spritz on itchy area & let air dry.

Good Morning Aroma Mist

8 drops Orange 6 drops Peppermint 6 drops Lime ~Spritz in room to start the day off right.

Spray On Deodorant

5 drops Frankincense 5 drops Lemon 5 drops Lavender ~Use alcohol free witch hazel instead of water, spray under arms & let air dry.

Sweet Dreams Room Spray

7 drops Lavender 7 drops Juniper Berry 6 drops Roman Chamomile ~Spritz in room before bedtime.

Bed Bug Away Spray

5 drops Clove 5 drops Peppermint 5 drops Lemongrass 5 drops Frankincense ~Spray on bare mattress, let air dry.

Rejuvenating Aroma Spray

10 drops Orange 6 drops Peppermint 4 drops Rosemary ~Mist around home or office as needed.

Orange Spice Air Freshener

10 drops Orange 5 drops Tangerine 5 drops Cinnamon ~Spray in any room to freshen air, perfect for bathroom.

Magnolia Bliss Room Spray

10 drops Magnolia 5 drops Bergamot 4 drops Sandalwood ~Spritz into air, enjoy the calming aroma.

Festive Kitchen Spray

12 drops Lime 8 drops cilantro 2 drops Black Pepper ~Spray in kitchen for a festive aroma.

Citrus Clean Surface Spray

6 drops Lemon
6 drops Lime
6 drops Orange
~Spray on household
or office surfaces, wipe
clean.

Holiday Spice Room Spray

8 drops Orange 6 drops Cinnamon 6 drops Clove ~Spray in house to enjoy a holiday aroma.

10 drops Lavender 5 drops Clary Sage 5 drops Orange ~Spritz in room or office to reduce stress.

8 drops Tea Tree 8 drops Lemon 4 drops Eucalyptus ~Spray in any room to freshen air, perfect for bathroom.

Germ Away Surface Spray

12 drops Lemon 6 drops Tea Tree 2 drops Oregano ~Spray on household surfaces & wipe clean.

Peaceful Child Aroma Mist

10 drops Vetiver
4 drops Frankincense
2 drops Roman
Chamomile
2 drops Clary Sage
2 drops Marjoram
~Spray as needed.

Outdoorsy Room Spray

8 drops Cedarwood 6 drops Tea Tree 3 drops Lavender 3 drops Frankincense ~Spray in room and enjoy the aroma.

Falling Leaves Room Spray

14 drops Orange 3 drops Patchouli 3 drops Ginger ~Spritz into air for a wonderful fall scent.

Focus Blend Aroma Mist

10 drops Peppermint 10 drops Orange ~Spray in air to help focus on the task at hand.

Naturally Clean Room Spray

15 drops Lavender 10 drops Tea Tree ~Spritz around area to freshen the air in a bathroom or guest room.

Herb Kitchen Spray

5 drops Spearmint 5 drops Rosemary 5 drops Eucalyptus 5 drops Lemon ~Spray in kitchen for an herbal makeover.

Fido Fart Be Gone Spray

8 drops Peppermint 8 drops Orange 4 drops Lemon ~Gassy dog? Spirtz this spray in the room.

Memory Boosting Spray

8 drops Peppermint 8 drops Patchouli 4 drops Rosemary ~Spray in air & deeply inhale aroma.

All Natural Hand Sanitizer Spray

10 drops Lemon
5 drops Lavender
5 drops Tea Tree
~Use alcohol free
witch hazel instead of
water, spray on hands,
rub & let air dry.

Full of Energy Aroma Mist

10 drops Grapefruit 5 drops Lavender 5 drops Pine ~Spray around your environment when you need energy.

Pumpkin Pie Room Spray

8 drops Cardamom 5 drops Orange 4 drops Cinnamon 3 drops Clove ~Spray in air for a scrumptious aroma.

Antibacterial Cleaning Spray

10 drops Lemon 5 drops Eucalyptus 5 drops Tea Tree -Spray on area to be cleaned & wipe off with microfiber cloth.

Lavender Fresh Linen Spray

14 drops Lavender 4 drops Peppermint 2 drops Lemon ~Spray onto linen for lavender freshness, allow to air dry.

Summer Fresh Air Freshener

10 drops Grapefruit 5 drops Ylang Ylang 5 drops Lavender ~Spray in air for a summer fresh scent.

No Dust Mites Spray

8 drops Lavender 6 drops Lemongrass 6 drops Tea Tree ~Spray on mattress & let air dry. Use spray on dusting cloth.

Thankful Home Room Spray

5 drops Ginger 5 drops Clove 5 drops Cinnamon 5 drops Coriander ~Spray to create a pleasant atmosphere.

Air Purification Room Spray

10 drops Lemon 5 drops Grapefruit 5 drops Cypress ~Spray into air to cleanse the space.

Joyful Blend Aroma Mist

6 drops Lemon 6 drops Lavender 4 drops Tangerine 4 drops Melissa ~Spray in air & deeply inhale the aroma.

Mountain Breeze Room Spray

10 drops Cypress 6 drops Lavender 4 drops Lemon ~Spray in air for a refreshing aroma.

A Walk in the Woods Spray

8 drops Frankincense 8 drops Douglas Fr 4 drops Cedarwood -Spray in air for a woodsy aroma.

Odor Away Bathroom Spray

10 drops Orange
5 drops Lavender
5 drops Lemon
~Spray around
bathroom to freshen
& get rid of odors.

Spring Fresh Aroma Mist

6 drops Geranium 5 drops Lemon 5 drops May Chang 4 drops Petitgrain ~Spray in air & deeply inhale aroma.

How To Label Your Bottles

Step 1: Cut out label for desired recipe, if blank label be sure to write recipe name on label.

Step 2: Cut out a piece of contact paper that is large enough to cover over the label but will still fit on your bottle. The contact paper also makes the bottle label water resistant.

Step 3: Peel off back of contact paper, this can be challenging but if you use your fingernail on the edge corner to slide between the contact paper and the paper backing you can get it to separate easier. Remove backing completely, being careful to not touch the back on anything or handle it too much with fingers.

Step 4: Attach cut out label to sticky side of contact paper, try to get it straight and in the middle. Practice makes perfect, do your best and over time you will get better.

Step 5: Line up sticker onto bottle sticking only center top and bottom until it is lined up, then wrap around rest of bottle.

Step 6: Smooth the sticker label out using your fingertips to rub over it, push out any bubbles and creases.

*As an alternative to this method you can use sticker paper. Just print out on sticker paper, cut out and stick onto bottle, this label will not be water resistant but fast & easy to use.

I have also used washi or masking tape and a sharpie



How To Use Gift Tags

You can use these gift tags on all kinds of projects and gift giving packages. They look adorable on DIY Recipe bottles. Also are stunning on gift bags and gift baskets. They can even spice up a wrapped present. Once printed out they are easy to apply to your gift or package, see the step by step picture tutorial.

How To Apply to Package/Gift:

Step 1: Pick the gift tag you want to use for the item you are gifting and print out on card stock paper, it is the best paper to make the tag ridged. You can print on regular paper if needed and then attach to a cardboard piece if you prefer.

Step 2: Cut the gift tag out and then punch a hole at the top where the white circle is by lining up the circle with a hole punch. Once lined up punch out circle. Write names on tags.

Step 3: Use ribbon, twine, yarn or string through the hole and attach to package. See our picture tutorial on how we like to do it. Once your tag is ready, apply to your gift or package!
