


Hard Wall Aluminium Sukkah - 3x6m Assembly Instructions



SAFETY WARNING - Please read before use

- Your Sukkahmart Sukkah and / or Rain Roof is intended for use in a protected garden or yard. Do not install your Sukkah in an open area which is exposed to high winds which may blow your Sukkah over.
- 2. If you are installing a Sukkah in an open area, we recommend that you use the Super Sukkah ONLY.
- SURRAITONLY.
- 3. Wherever you place your Sukkah, it is vital that you anchor your Sukkah down so that it cannot lift off the ground. If wind lifts the Sukkah off the ground, the Sukkah may collapse upon landing. This is especially important when using a Sukkah Roof.
- 4. You can weigh your Sukkah down, by placing sandbags or heavy objects on the bottom horizontal beam, or, for a Hard-Walled Sukkah on the anchoring brackets supplied. The Hard-Walled Sukkah also comes with adaptors which can be used to tie-down the Sukkah, or to fix the Sukkah to your house.

Hard Wall Aluminium Sukkah - 3x6 Sukkahma **Assembly Instructions**



The basic Sukkah kit is 3x6 Meters with a door and a window. Any size larger than this will come with separate 'extension' kits of 2 x 1 running meters or 2 x 2 running meters.

VERY IMPORTANT

The beams and panels are different sizes and it is crucial that you use the correct beams and panels in the correct places. The beams and panels are marked with colour stickers and it is essential that you follow this guide.

Basic Sukkah Kit 3x6 Contents

Door Beams and Panels (put these aside for your door)

Hinge Beams (2 beams joined together with hinges) -1

Handle Beam (beam with handle and latch on) -1

Hook Beam (beam with hook for latch on) - 1

Door Crossbeams (white sticker) - 3

Under Door Support Bracket (pink sticker) -1

White Panel with red sticker (top panel) -1

White Panel with green sticker (bottom panel) -1



Other Beams in Kit

4-slot Upright Beam (green sticker) - 8

2-slot Upright Beams (black sticker) - 8

2 Meter Crossbeam (blue sticker) - 8


1 Meter Crossbeam (yellow sticker) - 18

2 Meter Crossbeam (grey sticker) - 8

1 Meter Crossbeam (grey sticker) - 2

White Panel (with orange sticker) - 31

Clear panel (with orange sticker) - 3



Supporting Beams (install once Sukkah is up)

2 Meter Crossbeam (pink sticker) - 4

1 Meter Crossbeam (pink sticker) - 8

50cm Top Corner Support (pink sticker) - 4

30cm Anchoring Bracket (pink sticker) - 10

Tie Down/ Wall Fixing Adapter - 4


Cross Beam Joiner (pink sticker) - 6




Sukkah Elements Door (do NOT construct these yet)

Door beams and panels – (put these aside for your door)
Hinge Beams (2 beams joined together with hinges) - 1
Handle Beam (beam with handle and latch on) - 1
Hook Beam (beam with hook for latch on) - 1
Door Crossbeams (white sticker) - 3


2 Meter wall






How the beams join together


Inset the lock into the slot
Ensure they are flush against each other
Use the supplied tool to turn the bolt
The lock will lock the beam in place.



3 Meter Wall



To build a 3x6m Sukkah




Step 2 – Insert the first row of panels into the slots

Pic 1 – Panel going in
On a 2 meter wall, use a 2-slot upright beam between the two panels


NB: Panels are not exactly square.
Make sure you insert the panels long side up.

Pic 2 - 2 slot upright




Step 3 – Place a crossbeam on top of the panel, insert a second panel on top of the crossbeam and close the top off with a 1 or 2 meter crossbeam.

Leave a gap for your window.



Step 4 – To complete the door, place the white panel with the green sticker at the bottom, a 1 meter crossbeam on top of it, followed by the white panel with the red sticker and another 1 meter crossbeam.




Under Door Support Bracket

Step 5 – Place the window in whichever panel you want it to be.

Step 6 – Place top supports ontop of your Sukkah for added strength (Pink Stickers).

Step 7 – Use remaining supports to anchor your sukkah.
