The BRADLEY Iron finish collection encompasses a wide range of coating types and application techniques including, water-based, hand-applied finishes, sprayed automotive finishes, gilded precious metals, and enamel powder coat finishes that can be applied to our any of our iron, aluminum or stainless steel furnishings products. Our goal is to offer a wide selection of metal finishes that satisfy all styles from contemporary to traditional as well as deliver the performance and durability that you would expect from artisan made luxury furnishings. Selecting the correct finish for your BRADLEY product requires some thought and insight about the end-use application and the planned location of the piece. ## STANDARD IRON FINISHES

- BRADLEY Standard Iron finishes are typically metallic or opaque base coatings that are wet sprayed over a
  durable metal primer layer and finished with a protective clear top coat for improved durability.
- Our Standard Iron finishes are relatively easy to touch up at the customer site with basic finishing skills and tools.

## ARTISAN IRON FINISHES

- BRADLEY Artisan Iron finishes are multi-step coatings, meticulously applied by our artisans over a durable metal primer coat and finished with a protective clear top coat for improved durability.
- Certain Artisan and Premium finishes may not be available on every BRADLEY furnishing due to the complex geometry of the design.
- Due to the hand applied nature of these Artisan finishes, variations from lot-to-lot in color, brush strokes, texture, and gloss level are common and may differ slightly from our marketing samples; this is considered an expected and desired characteristic of artisan applied finishes and not a manufacturing defect.
- Our Brushed Iron finish is a mechanically grinded surface finish on ferrous steel and top coated with a
  protective clear lacquer. Due to the ferrous (iron) content of the base metal, a light reddish-brown patina
  (oxidation) or spotting may occur with time; this is not considered a manufacturing defect and not
  covered under our Product Warranty. If the potential for oxidation or patina is objectionable, then the
  customer should select Brushed Stainless Steel as an alternate.

## PREMIUM IRON FINISHES

- BRADLEY Premium Iron finishes are multi step coatings, meticulously applied over based and primer coats by our most talented artisans.
- Due to the hand applied nature of these Premium finishes, variations from lot-to-lot in color, brush strokes, texture, and gloss level are common and may differ slightly from our marketing samples; this is considered an expected and desired characteristic of artisan applied finishes and not a manufacturing defect.
- Note that our Rubbed Bronze and metal leaf finishes (i.e. gilded) are delicate finishes and not recommended for horizontal surfaces like table tops or other areas that will have frequent contact by the user
- Powder coat finishes are durable coatings and recommended where maximum durability and resistance
  to high humidity is needed, however, powder coat finishes are not a guarantee against rust, chipping or
  abrasion. Powder coat finishes are suggested for furnishings that will be exposed to outdoor conditions or
  high humidity. However the finish or the base metal is not warranted for outdoor use.
- No BRADLEY finishes are warranted against fading, peeling, abrasion, or rust/corrosion under any
  circumstance if used outdoors or other misuse/neglect. Due to the delicate nature of these metal finishes,
  care should be taken when handling or cleaning the product. See the BRADLEY Care and Maintenance
