

WOOD INFORMATION

BRADLEY wood finishes are results of years of thoughtful selection and careful development and testing. Our wood finishes are applied in our American finishing shops by artisans that take pride in their work and that each piece is finished to our exacting standards.

WOOD FINISH NOTES

STAINED FINISHES

- BRADLEY stained wood finishes are available in a limited selection of wood species, stain colors and top coat luster, however under certain circumstances we can provide alternate wood species and custom stains to match your sample finish submission. Once we determine if we can match a custom stain, we will provide a strikeoff for approval. Upcharges apply.

PEARLIZED AND PAINTED FINISHES

- BRADLEY Pearlized painted finishes require a multi-step finishing technique and contain hand mixed pearlescent additives to achieve its unique appearance. Due to the hand-mixed and applied nature of this finish, variations can occur from piece to piece and may not be an exact match to showroom samples or digital representation of the color palette.
- Note that the pearlized layer can be optionally brushed or sprayed depending on the desired effect.
- Pearlized finishes are top coated with a protective clear coat, but the delicate finish should still be treated like that of a fine antique.
- BRADLEY can provide custom match paint colors based on Benjamin Moore and Sherwin Williams color palettes. Upcharges apply. Contact your BRADLEY representative for more information.

RECLAIMED OAK FINISHES

- BRADLEY Reclaimed Oak finishes are applied to salvaged “reclaimed” wood boards that have been resurfaced to make usable lumber for our table tops and case pieces. The surface of the lumber has been planed and sanded to make the product safe and functional for everyday use. Our repurposed wood contains natural exposed knots, checks, cracks and nail holes that you would expect from salvaged lumber. The amount of these character marks can vary from piece to piece.
- The designer may specify the intensity or amount of the character marks in the piece as light, medium or heavy; we will make every attempt to honor this request, but there is no guarantee that this will match your expectations as this is a very subjective characteristic to measure.
- Note that due to the salvaged nature of reclaimed oak lumber, it is unlike conventional new lumber that has been factory kiln-dried, and thus reclaimed oak can contain a wider range of internal moisture content. Warping of reclaimed lumber is more common, and due to this, our table tops that are constructed of joined boards, may contain a “bearer” support or other structure installed under the top to help prevent warping after it leaves our factory.

METAL LEAF/GILDED FINISHES

- BRADLEY metal leaf and gilded finishes utilize time honored gilding techniques and top quality materials. Due to the handmade nature of this finish, variations can occur from piece to piece and may not be an exact match to showroom samples or digital representation of the color palette.
- Note that the metal leaf finish can utilize a range of gilded techniques that allows for more or less bare areas called “holidays” depending on the desired effect.
