## How To Measure Your Bra Size

Step 1:
Measure your band


Wrap a soft measuring tape just below your bust. Make sure it's even in the back.

A: Original underbust measurement $\qquad$ inches

Step 3:
Measure your bust


Wrap a soft measuring tape around the fullest part of your bust. Make sure it's even in the back.

C: Bust measurement $\qquad$ inches

## Step 2:

Calculate your band size

| MEASURMENT IN INCHES | HOW TO CALCULATE BAND SIZE |
| :--- | :--- |
| $26-32$ | If even, add 4. If odd, add 5 |
| $33-38$ | If even, add 2. If odd, add 3 |
| $39+$ | If even, add 0. If odd, add 1 |

Write down your band measurement from step 1. Using the chart above, calculate your band size.

B: Calculated band size $\qquad$ inches

## Step 4:

Calculate your cup size


Take your original band measurement from step 1 and subtract it from your bust measurement in step 3 . Use that number to determine your cup size based on the chart above. Your calculated band size (B) plus your cup size (see chart) is your final bra size.

C minus $A=$ $\qquad$

Pro tip: If your original band measurement in step 1 is below 32 inches and you're getting a number that doesn't seem reasonable, try adding 2 to your band measurement before you subtract it from your cup size.
