##### **Surface**

> Writing surface is an acrylic material that is chemically bonded to the steel sheet.

##### **Features and Use**

- > Commercial Whiteboards are more lightweight in comparison to the Porcelain Boards as they use a lighter gauge steel sheet base.
- > Are more porous so marker solvents will penetrate the surface over time and mark.
- > Commercial Whiteboards are recommended as a low use, general home and office whiteboard.
