Vintage: 2007

Varietal Content: 80% Syrah, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

Barrel regime: All wines were aged in various new and older French oak barrels for 21 months

Alcohol: 14.6% alcohol by volume

Cloudy's Tasting Notes: Deep, dense and intimidating dark purple colors precede a voluptuous, heady palate of black fruit, a balanced texture and intensity. This vintage possesses considerable power interwoven with significant elegance and definition.

The Wine Advocate, 12/09: The opaque purple-hued 2007 Vagabond (a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, and a touch of Viognier) offers a big, sweet kiss of spring flowers, black fruits, spice, charcoal, and a hint of road tar. Dense and layered, but light on its feet for so much fruit and richness, it should drink well for 6-8 years. Rating 90 points

Vineyard Sources: The Syrah is derived from the Caldwell Vineyard in Coombsville area in Napa. The Cabernet Sauvignon comes from the Vineyard Georges III in Rutherford.
