2010 Vagabond Syrah

One of our most powerful vintages of Vagabond since it's inception in 2004, the 2010 vintage stands out for its depth, textural richness and incredible structure. The nose offers aromas of ripe berries, with hints of smoky tobacco and mocha. The palate is texturally opulent with varietal definition and nuance. Dark, rich red fruit comes through immediately on the palate, with notes of white pepper and other spice-box characteristics coming through in the finish. The wine fleshes out beautifully in the glass, showing off its character and 'Coombsville' pedigree.
