## 2013 Lucie Dutton Ranch Chardonnay

To anyone familiar with Sonoma County wines, the name Dutton Ranch needs no introduction. These premier growers are renowned for their viticultural practices and the ideal soils for Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Our Chardonnay is sourced from Russian River Valley vines that are planted in coveted Goldridge soil. In our quest to produce an understated Chardonnay we picked our fruit earlier. The fruit was whole-cluster pressed to preserve maximum quality and we chose not to allow malolactic fermentation. The resulting wine is infused with citrus aromas and rich meringue flavors. While crisp and clean, it is incredibly rich on the palate. The longer the wine is open, the more infectious its appeal in aroma and flavor.
