Instructions for use



Early detection of a Urinary Track Infection (UTI)



- 1. Collect a fresh sample of urine in a clean vessel.
- 2. Dip a test strip into the urine for 1 second, ensuring all test squares are covered.
- 3. Test strip will show test results within 60 seconds.
- 4. Compare the used test strip to the strip on the container.

Results:

LEU - a purple colour suggests a possible infection - Positive UTI.

NIT - a pink colour suggests a possible bacterial infection - Positive UTI.

UBG & ERY - indicators represent blood in urine, if significant change consult a doctor

LEU and NIT changes indicate a UTI, you must seek medical attention promptly. Note: for a detailed review consult insert leaflet.
