

# MOUNTING

The Firefield MG "Kemper XL" Machine Gun Reflex Sight includes an integrated rail that fits standard weaver bases. Due to the unlimited eye relief, the sight can be mounted at any position on your firearm. For safety reasons, allow at least three inches of clearance between the end of the sight and your eye when shooting. To mount:

- 1. The sight comes with built-in weaver mount (4).
- 2. Unload the weapon. Remove the bolt/firing pin to ensure the weapon isi incapable of firing.
- 3. Install the sight onto a weaver or picatinny base. Tighten the screws between 45-65 inch pounds of torque.
- 4. Once the alignment is checked, tighten the mouting screw. Take care not to overtighten the screw.
- 5. Ensure the sight provides the desired eye relief by moving the weapon into the shooting position.
- 6. Check that the sight is evenly mounted, and boresight the sight.

#### BORESIGHTING THE REFLEX SIGHT

Boresighting and test firing should be performed safely on a firing range. Laser boresights are a quick and accurate method to sighting in optical sights. Below is listed the traditional method of boresighting.

- I. When mounting the reflex sight on a bolt action rifle, remove the bolt; or when mounting to a smi automatic rifle, disassemble the rifle until there is a striaght line of sight through the bore.
- 2. Use a target at least twenty yards to fifty yards away when sighting in the reflex sight. Look through the bore of the weapon and locate the bull's-eye of the target.
- 3. Sight in the target through the bore and then make windage and elevation adjustments (see "Operating Windage and Elevation Adjustments" for instructions) to the reflex sight until the reticle is centere on the bull's eye.

To verify the reflex sight is accurately sighted in, always fire a three-shot test group at 50 to 100 yards.

- 4. If you are still off center, make the necessary amount of adjustments to move the reticle to the center of the target.
- 5. Again fire a three-shot test group, and use the center of the group to determine final adjustments.

# OPERATING WINDAGE AND ELEVATION ADJUSTMENTS

In order to make windage and elevation adjustments (20 the included allen wrench is needed. "Up" and "R" (right) are marked on the sight for adjustment reference. Rotate the adjustment with the allen wrench as needed to adjust the reticle to the point of impact. The windage and elevation adjustments are I MOA, meaning that I click moves the point of impact I linch at I 00 yards.



### INSTALLING THE BATTERY

The Firefield MG"Kemper XL" Machine Gun Reflex Sight is powered by one CR2032 battery. Should the reticle grow dim or not illuminate, the battery needs to be replaced. To install a new battery:

- I. Unscrew the battery cap located on the reticle brightness adjustment (3) counterclockwise.
- 2. Remove the battery.
- 3. Insert the new battery with the positive (+) side facing up.
- 4. Screw the battery cap clockwise. Do not overtighten.

#### MAINTANENCE

Proper maintenance of the reflex sight is recommended to ensure longevity. It is recommended that when the reflex sight becomes dirty that it is wiped down with a dry or slightly damp cloth. Blow dirt and debris off all optics and then clean lenses with a lens cleaning cloth. No further maintenance is required. Not following instructions can cause damage to the unit and void the warranty.

# **WARNING**

Before handling the Firefield MG "Kemper XL" Machine Gun Reflex Sight, read and understand the contents of your firearm's manual, and the firefield reflex sight manual. Follow all standard safety precautions and prodecureds during firearm operation, even when the reflex sight is not in use.

- · Avoid hitting or dropping the unit
- ALWAYS check that the chamber of your weapon is clear before moutning or dismounting the reflex sight.
- · ALWAYS remove the reflex sight when cleaning, or performing other maintenance, on your firearm.
- The reflex sight should be tested during periods of non-use to make sure it is still operating properly. Failure to follow standard firearm safety precautions and procedures, as well as the above warnings, is dangerous and may result in serious injury, damage to property, or death.

### **STORAGE**

Make sure that the Firefield MG "Kemper XL" Machine Gun Reflex Sight is securely attached to your rifle before storing, and be sure the unit is turned off. Remove the reflex sight, and the batteries, if the unit will be stored for an extended period of time
