

## PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS

### HOW TO IDENTIFY A PROGRAMMABLE PATCHBAY

968-S Series programmable patchbays can only be identified by removing the top dust cover and looking for the presence of red and white programming shunts inside.



### HOW TO CHANGE THE PROGRAMMING FOR A CIRCUIT

- 1: Remove the top dust cover to expose the programming shunts.
- 2: Find your desired configuration in the diagram.
- 3: Arrange the programming shunts to match the appropriate diagram. Note: Each circuit can be programmed independently.
- 4: Ample shunts are provided with every patchbay. Red shunts are placed horizontally and are used for normalizing. White shunts are placed vertically and are used for grounding.
- 5: Replace the dust cover.
