

Hang in There Tutorial by Jeannie Lieu



When I saw the Woodland Foliage Frames, I loved how they include multiple frames and I knew that I wanted to create a frame using the two smaller frames. When I die cut the frame out, I decided to make a shaker card. I also used the Safari stamp and die set, stamping out the vine and the monkey using Raven Hybrid Ink. For the monkey, I used the die included in the set to cut him out. Since I manipulated the vine to be longer, I had to fussy cut that image.

Although the frame would have been enough, I really wanted to use the Super Sprigs to decorate the frame. I inked up some paper using a random variety of green inks and die cut several of these sprigs. After doing this, I added a piece of acetate to the frame and stamped on the "Hang In there" sentiment directly on it. I wanted it to be front and center on the card.



Once I put together the frame, I add foam tape to add the dimension I need to make this card a shaker.





I just add the bits I want to use inside the shaker and my card is done. I think it's a perfect card to help brighten any one's day.
