What

PFCs are widely used, long-lasting chemicals, components of which break down very slowly over time.

Various types of PFCs have been used over the years in products and on materials due to their enhanced water-resistant properties. PFCs can include PFOS, PFOA and other PFAS chemicals, which are commonly described as persistent organic pollutants or "forever chemicals" because of the time they remain in the environment.

Where We Are

Turtle Fur's current product line does not contain intentionally added PFCs in any of our products via raw material or production methods.

Turtle Fur has utilized third-party independent laboratories to confirm that the fabrics we utilize are PFC-Free.

Turtle Fur is committed to developing PFC-free goods in all new products that we introduce.

Turtle Fur continues to be involved with industry groups such as the Outdoor Industry Association and Vermont Outdoor Business Alliance as our industry moves towards a PFC & PFAS-free future.
