Registering for an InvestIN programme is a simple and straightforward process.

If you have paid via deposit, the outstanding fees must be paid by 31st March 2024.

You will be invited to complete a pre-arrival form

- if you are attending one of our Summer Experiences up to 3 months in advance.

ENROLMENT REQUIREMENTS

Subject Knowledge

Students do not require any prior industry knowledge or experience in order to attend an InvestIN programme. Our programmes are suited for students who are enthusiastic and passionate about their chosen career, whilst our professionals are here to coach students on everything they need to know!

Language Proficiency

Our programmes are delivered entirely in English and we require a minimum CEFR level of B2 (upper-intermediate) in order to attend.

Visas

Students who require a visa to enter the UK should obtain a Standard Visitor Visa (the same that is used by tourists) for "study at an accredited institution". We can issue letters in support of visa applications once a student has registered for a place on a programme.
