Remove the safety lid by placing your thumb under the thumb tab and pushing upward.

Turn the applicator dial counterclockwise to apply your specific dose, as instructed by your pharmacist or doctor. DIAL as many CLICKS as instructed.

After dialing your dosage, wait at least 5-10 seconds in order to give the transdermal preparation ample time to exit the container through the hole and collect at the the top. Follow your doctor or pharmacist's instructions for how to apply the medication. If desired, apply the cream directly with the Ticker by rubbing the dispenser cap against the area of skin specified.

Prevent evaporation of your transdermal preparation by properly securing the safety lid. (TIP: Some of the water that makes the bulk of the preparation may evaporate without the safety cap) Store your medication away from excessive heat or sunlight.

When the top part plunger of the reaches the extruded word "REFILL" (as shown), it is time to refill your medication. There are approximately 6-7 mililiters remaining.
