4 OH, HORTENSIA!

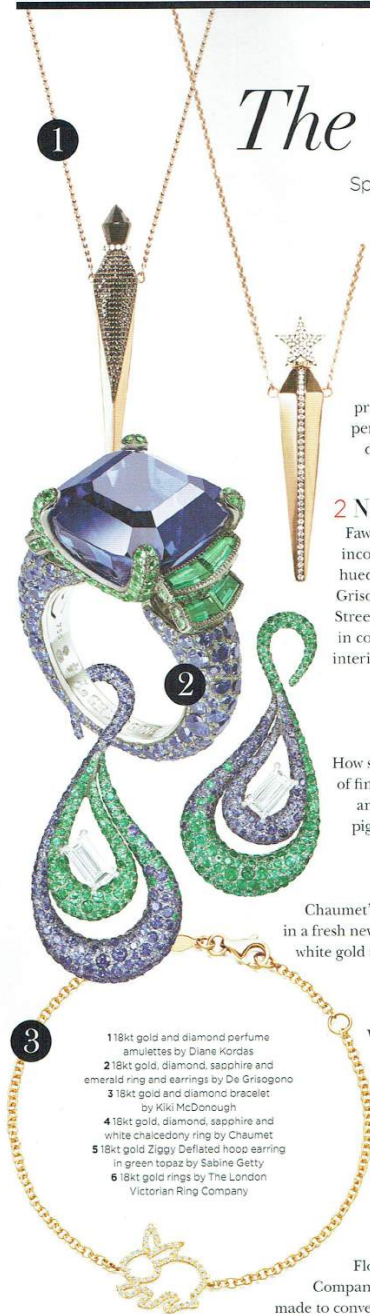
