# TRADITION REIMAGINED



## IT'S BEEN 58 DAYS SINCE IT RAINED.

Dust rolled behind us as we drove up to Travis and Mandy Krause's home at Parker Creek Ranch. We spent the day there, cameras in hand, talking about how they're reimagining long-held traditions - something we're quite fond of at Tecovas.

Travis' family has been working the land near D'Hanis, Texas, since 1846. Like most of the land around it, it's mainly operated as a cow-calf operation where brush, native and improved grasses, and bull mesquites cover the 629 acres. When they returned to the ranch 10 years ago, it was clear that making a living off the land would be immensely challenging. The soil was devoid of nutrients needed to grow plants that support livestock. Periods of drought only made it worse. The Krauses had a choice to make - follow the path of conventional agriculture and crank up herbicides, pesticides, and irrigation systems, or try something else. Across the fence, conventional agriculture had manicured fields of green for miles. At Travis' feet was parched, depleted soil. They found their direction in "regenerative ranching."

In the early 1800s, an estimated 50 to 70 million bison grazed, aerated, and fertilized the plains from Texas through Canada. They spread native grass seeds as they moved, and flocks of birds followed and fed on the insects churned up from the soil. When the herd moved on, all the nutrition left behind started the cycle again. There was a balance that was good for all living things. Regenerative ranching aims to create the same sustainable, cyclical system with livestock on fenced land.

Day after day, you'll find the Krauses running temporary electric fences to parcel pastures, herding cattle, wrangling pigs, gathering eggs, and moving

By challenging convention, the Krauses have bettered the odds of sustaining their family homestead for generations to come. Travis commented, "Think about how carefully designed everything is these days. How integrated are 'smart' systems into our daily lives. It's because people saw a better way to do things. Why should agriculture be different? If there's a better way, we should be chasing it." At Tecovas, we think reimagining traditions is one of the best ways to keep traditions alive. Travis and Mandy, we wish you well and are praying for rain with you.



wheeled chicken coops and turkey shelters. It's all in an effort to have the livestock quickly break up and fertilize the hard ground. A hundred head of cattle might spend a single day on 4 acres before they're moved to the next pasture. And they won't return for up to 180 days.

This was not the easy route to success. Add the pressure of a cattle-ranching father watching you herd chickens, and you can imagine it's been emotionally taxing too. But it's working. In fact, the organic matter in their soil has gone from 1% to 5%. Native grasses have returned, which feeds more livestock per acre. When it rains, less water runs off and the creek stays wet longer. Their products are in demand at farmers' markets, restaurants, meat markets, and boutique grocery stores. And some of the nearby skeptics, who laughed in the beginning, are asking for advice. Even Dad's suspicions have cooled. A little.

# **THE OBSTACLE IS THE OPPORTUNITY**



MICAH FINK'S FATHER ONCE TOLD HIM that the key to success was to "look at what everyone else is doing, and do the exact opposite." We agree. At Tecovas, we believe that there's always a better way to do things. With that, we're proud to share this remarkable story about people who are forging their own path to help veterans.

Micah Fink saw the attack on the Twin Towers from a telephone pole while working as a lineman in Queens. With a coworker, he rushed into the city to help, emerging from the chaos a day later. Physically and emotionally exhausted, he resolved to "do something about it." And he did. Micah became a Navy Seal and later a paramilitary contractor, spending over 1,100 days in Iraq, Afghanistan, and other hotspots around the world. When he returned to civilian life, like many vets, he was completely lost.

Micah had spent the better part of his adulthood in high-pressure, life-anddeath situations day after day. When that life ended, the transition from soldier to civilian wasn't something that anyone had prepared him for. As a solution for his struggles, the VA told him he had PTSD and handed him a list of prescriptions. It didn't feel right. He walked out that day and never returned, as he could see that this approach was short-sighted and didn't address his core issues. The over-prescribing of medications, fun vacations, and shielding veterans from stress-inducing situations were common themes among existing







PTSD-relief programs. Micah knew that he needed something different and transformational. The problem was that alternative solution didn't exist.

He eventually found himself working with horses in the solitude of Montana. Initially, he was taught to use force, fear, and repetition to have the horses submit to his command. He joked, "I was starting wars when I needed to be having negotiations." With help from some older cowboys, he realized that this approach was backwards and soon began to experience the transformative potential for personal growth in the relationship between horse and human. Breaking horses and traveling deep into dangerous backcountry, Micah focused only on the "present." The challenges forced him to look inward for answers. True transformation began to happen. Exhausted, tired, and pushed to his limit, he realize that he already had what he was looking for. These moments, triggered by shared pressure and mutual respect between human and horse, got him thinking about how he could share this experience with more veterans who were struggling. That's when Heroes and Horses was born.

"It's struggle that gives everything in life value. It provides us the opportunity to learn about who we truly are. During the struggle, WE BEGIN LEARNING FROM THE INSIDE OUT. It is in this place we gain strength and knowledge, making new and

authentic choices that turn all our obstacles into opportunities."

The Heroes and Horses program takes a small group (usually eight) of veterans through 40 days of, what they call, a "360-degree approach to addressing the mental and physical obstacles veterans face." Daily lessons are had in horsemanship, riding, equine medicine, backcountry survival, packtraining, physical fitness, leadership, and healthy eating. But the backbone of the program is built around the horse and human relationship. Micah explained, "If I have a veteran who is angry, I pair him with a horse that's very nervous. The vet has no option but to slow down, take deep breaths, and make it work, or that horse is going to do really bad things to him. If I have

a guy who's riddled with guilt, I give him a gentle horse. The arrogant guy gets a horse that all the other horses bully. When these guys see that their behavior changes the behavior of the horse, that's when things really start to open up. We then put that partnership in extremely stressful situations where the animal will look to the veteran for leadership, and they have to step up. Honestly, that relationship does the majority of the talking for the program, we just point it out. I mean, if I tell some guy what all of his problems are, that doesn't do anything for him. But, if the horse makes him look in the mirror pretty much all day for 40 days in a row, that'll probably sink in."

The initial 40-day program culminates in an 11-day pack trip through some of the most challenging terrain in the lower 48. Here, anything can happen at any moment. And from pack mules who rebel and attack to cliffside trails no wider than a horse to dangerous encounters with grizzly bears, it has all happened at one time or another. Each veteran's commitment to himself is tested for 40



days and more than 400 collective miles in the saddle. For those who make it to graduation, it's an accomplishment worth holding on to. As we watched the graduates pack up to leave, Micah said, "When they go home, they have tools. When things get tough, they can stop and realize they have the superpower of making their own choice. And making our own choices is what makes us free."

We're proud to put Tecovas boots, jeans, and belts on Heroes and Horses graduates as they return home, and we are sure rooting for them. We hope you'll look up Heroes and Horses and consider lending your support too.

# AN AUTHEN TIC PURSUIT

NIKKI LANE'S AUTHENTICITY WAS ONCE described as being "as unapologetic as Johnny Cash's middle finger." We don't disagree. For a musician (or a boot company) who's producing something that hearkens back to long-held traditions from decades gone by, authenticity is no easy line to walk. Nikki is forging her own way and writing her own rules. We like that kind of thinking at Tecovas.

Nikki Lane walks into Sam's Town Point in South Austin in a vintage western suit. It's early afternoon and a small crew is prepping for the photoshoot. The smell of last night's beer and fun still hangs in the air. "Let's put on some music," she says, as she makes her way to the sound booth, which is surrounded by shelves full of old LPs.

Nikki's second home, which she shares with her boyfriend, songwriter Jonathan Tyler, is less than a hundred steps out the back door of Sam's Town Point. When they're not in Nashville or on the road, they're likely here. Throughout the day, as we snapped photos, we had a meandering conversation with Nikki about why they set up shop here and what it has to offer as she continues to define and explore her own musical prowess.

"We've been just sort of hiding out down here. And you know, my music so far is sort of hard to pin down. 'Outlaw' seems to be the way people sum it up. But, I want to be a country singer even if it leans toward rock 'n' roll.

When the things we make hearken back to long-held traditions, there's a fine line between being authentic and simply being an imitation. You have to study the traditions and treat them with respect. And then, in your own way, you offer the world something that's rich with heritage and brand new at the same time. It's true whether you're making music or boots.





And I want to learn about it and really understand it. And living in the backyard of a roadhouse where two-step music plays every night, what better way to learn it than from people that are playing it."

On any given night here, Nikki and Jonathan watch a band play and pick their brains afterwards. Since Jonathan built a proper recording studio in the house nearby, they can also easily collaborate on the fly with these folks. This easy access to inspiration and education is becoming their own honky tonk graduate school. And when you're bent on authenticity like Nikki, there's just no substitute for rubbing elbows with the real thing.
