Our 4-week Puppy 101 Classes are fun, educational, and fuzzy toy is included (yes, there will be fuzzy toys)!

Puppies 8-13 weeks old may join the Puppy 101 class any week with our innovative ongoing format! Sign up for 4 sessions and you can start as early as this week. This class also includes our free 1-hour talk on how dogs learn, communicate and understand the canine mind.

Puppies must have one set of shots from a veterinarian and be on a worming program. Records of shots must be brought to the first class.

Please bring proof of vaccinations from a veterinarian.**

### **Within every 4-week continuous session, we will talk about:**

Basic training skills, including: Sit, down, walking on a leash, and recall games. It also includes confidence-building skills, including walking on different surfaces, things you go in and out of, things that move, the many different kinds of sounds your puppy will hear.

### **PUPPY SPECIAL**

A 4 week class plus 10 days of puppy daycare.

The Dancin' Woofs Puppy Socialization Special in Bend includes a 4-week puppy class and 10 days of puppy daycare for \$305. That's a \$70 savings as we also wave the interview fee for daycare.

### **Please Read Before Coming to Class**

An exercise session before class will ensure that your puppy will be more focused. Play in your yard for 15-20 minutes. This will also give them a chance to relieve themselves outside. Also, some puppy's seem to be more attentive without a full stomach.

### **Keep All Puppies Three Feet Apart**

This is a training situation and it is a social skill for puppies to learn that they don't always have to greet every dog they see. Play time will be supervised during class.

### **Training Gear**

Comfortable clothing will allow you and your puppy to play, cuddle, massage, and get down on the floor together. Chairs will be provided if it is hard for you to work from the floor.

Quick-release buckle collar works fine for puppy class.

6-foot leather or nylon leash. Width of lead should correspond to size of puppy and comfort in your hand. Retractable leashes do not work in this environment. You can purchase in our retail area if needed.

Training treats: Use high-grade treats without by-products or preservatives, and lots of variety, this keeps interest high. You can purchase in our retail area if needed.

Toys: Your first class, you will be receiving a fun fuzzy toy to help with biting. You can also bring a favorite toy to help keep your puppy entertained.

### **Attendance**

Your puppy should not be older than 16 weeks in this class. 4 weeks in succession is best. Yes! Bring Family Members to Observe and Train. All we ask is that one person work the puppy during each class. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by a non-participating adult at all times while on premise.

### **General Policies**

- All puppies should be on leash.
- Please clean up after your puppy outside with bags provided, and if the puppy goes inside the training center, please let the puppy finish, then move away so we can clean it up.
- All puppy's must be in good health, and physically sound. If your puppy is acting sick, please do not come to class that day. Call if you have questions.

### **Refund Policy**

- If a client cancels after start date and wants a refund, it will be prorated.
