


At the bottom of every page, each sight word is labelled with a different colour. Find each of the words in the illustration and colour the section around it in the right colour!

Designed for children who are fluent readers (in Year 1 or Year 2). Find the sight words hidden on the page. Use the list at the bottom of the page to guide your search!




HIDDEN WORDS

Colour the picture according to the sight words crayon chart on the bottom of the page. Read the three surprise sight words that appear on the page!




