



Each resource features three sight word exercises of gradually increasing difficulty, plus a bonus "trace the letters" activity.


At the bottom of every page, each sight word is labeled with a different color. Find each of the words in the illustration and color the section around it in the right color!



#### **WORD SEARCH**



Designed for children who are fluent readers (in Grade 1 or Grade 2). Find the sight words hidden on the page. Use the list at the bottom of the page to guide your search!




#### **HIDDEN WORDS**

Color the picture according to the sight words crayon chart on the bottom of the page. Read the three surprise sight words that appear on the page!


