## **DRYSUIT TESTING**

- 1. Flip the drysuit inside out, zip up the suit ensuring the closure is fastened tightly.
- 2. Using a bungee cord, tie off one wrist seal and the neck seal.
- 3. Prepare a bucket with soapy water.
- 4. Place your air source in the open wrist seal, sealing the closure with your hands.
- 5. Fill the suit with air.
- 6. Begin dabbing the suit in the suspected areas in order to identify any leaks.
- 7. Mark the effected area with a pen and let the suit dry before repairing.
