

DAY 1 – LUKE 22:1-6

 - a. What is the Feast of Unleavened Bread? (See Ex 12:14-20; Lv 23:4-8)
 - b. How did this feast prefigure what Christ would accomplish? (See 1 Cor 5:8)
 - c. List the similarities between the Feast of Unleavened Bread and the Eucharistic Celebration today.

 - a. What allowed Satan to enter Judas? (See Jn 12:4-6)
 - b. How can you guard against Satan's influence in your life?

DAY 2 – LUKE 22:7-13

3. Explain the feast of Passover. (See Ex 12:1-51)
4. In the New Testament, Jesus is referred to as the Lamb of God (Jn 1:29; 1 Cor 5:7; 1 Pt 1:19). List the parallels between Jesus and the Passover Lamb. (See also Ex 12:1-51; Jn 19:31-37)
5. How is the Eucharist the fulfillment of the Passover? (See CCC 1340)

DAY 3 – LUKE 22:14-20

6. What is the meaning of "Do this in memory of me"? (See also CCC 1341, 1363-1366)
7. Read the account of the Eucharistic celebration from St Justin Martyr around the year 155 from the Catechism – CCC 1345. List the similarities to the Catholic Mass today.
8. In addition to the Eucharist, what other sacrament is instituted in this passage? (See CCC 611)

DAY 4 – LUKE 22:21-38

9. In verses 29-30, how is Jesus perpetuating His authority on earth? (See CCC 551-552, 765)
10. What was Jesus' prayer for Simon alone?
11. Jesus predicted Peter's denial. How do we deny the Lord either by word, by deed, or by omission?

DAY 5 – LUKE 22:39-46

12. How will Jesus' posture and prayer to the Father influence your own prayers?
13.
 - a. Read Matthew's account of the Agony in the Garden (Mt 26:36-46). What did Jesus say to Peter in Matthew's account that is not found in Luke's account?
 - b. In addition to the Mass, Catholics have the unique opportunity of spending "one hour" with Jesus truly present in the Eucharist. If you are aware of this devotion, please explain it to your group.
