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Chest:
Chest at Widest Point



Sleeve:
Can use preferred Sleeve length from Existing jackets
Measure From point of shoulder, to where you wish cuff to stop



Neck:
Bagpipers need to simulate playing the pipes, as this can expand your neck dramatically



Shoulder Width:
Point of shoulder to point of shoulder.

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**Front Length:
Base of throat,
to waist***

***see waist for reference**



Back Length

Nape of Neck to Waist*

Nape: Point where neck meets shoulders

***See waist measurement for reference**



**Around Shoulders:
Measure around shoulders
with arms down**
