

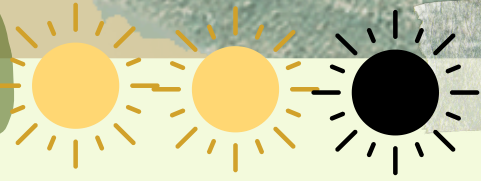
Anthurium Clarinervium

Anthurium clarinervium

The Anthurium Clarinervium is an epiphytic anthurium, found near the rainforest floor, underneath the dense canopy. These large, heart-shaped leaves have very prominent veins that look like a skeleton of the leaf, which is unusual for this type of plant.

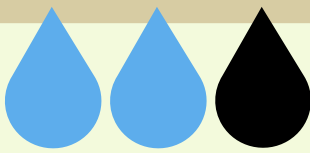
LIGHTING



Medium-bright is best; too bright and the leaves will fade, while not enough and the plant can die!



WATERING



Give your Anthurium Clarinervium a drink when about 1/2 of the substrate has dried out.



HUMIDITY

Definitely give your Clarinervium extra humidity if at all possible!



FUN FACTS

If your Anthurium starts to show roots above the soil at its base, mound some sphagnum moss around them and keep it moist!
