*Anthurium polyschistum*

An unusual anthurium sometimes called 'Anthurium Fingers', Polyschistum is a vining, climbing plant with leaves that are separated into 7 or 9 different leaflets, radiating out from the centre. Its strange leaves and interesting growth habit make it an eye-catcher!

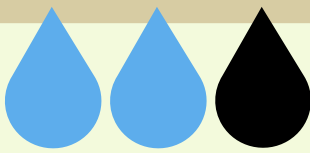
## LIGHTING



Medium-bright light at a minimum is best for Anthurium Polyschistum, encouraging faster growth and bigger leaves.



## WATERING



Anthuriums, including Polyschistum, have fairly average watering needs -- water when the top 1/2 of the substrate is dry!



## HUMIDITY

Anthurium Polyschistum prefers higher than average humidity, though in a pinch, it'll adapt.



## FUN FACTS

Anthuriums grow 'stilt roots' that can benefit from heaping a mound of sphagnum moss over the crown of the plant and keeping that moist.
