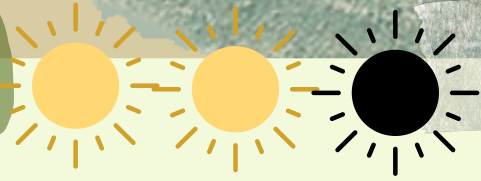
Lemon Lime

Dracaena fragrans 'Lemon Lime'

Dracaena Lemon Lime is one of the most common cultivars of Dracaena fragrans in cultivation. The long, straplike leaves that grow from a whorl at the top of the stem are dark green down the middle, flanked on either side by wide stripes of yellow-green -- hence the common name Lemon Lime!

LIGHTING



Brighter growth will encourage quicker growth, but in general your Lemon Lime can stay in medium lighting just fine!



WATERING



Despite being a cousin of the moisture-hating snake plants, Dracaena Lemon Lime prefers to be kept moist -- but you can let it dry out a bit as well!



HUMIDITY

As a tropical tree species, Lemon Limes prefer higher humidity, but adapt super well to average levels.



FUN FACTS

Believe it or not, Dracaena Lemon Lime is a young tree! Old leaves will fall off, leaving behind a stem, and if you prune it, it'll branch.
