## Mailiki Lime

*Dracaena fragrans* 'Mailiki Lime'

This is a less-common, but striking, variety of Dracaena!

Only the very edges of the long, straplike leaves have dark green, with white, pale green, and a stripe of lime green down the centre. This is a slightly more compact than usual form of dracaena, with smaller leaves than most varieties!

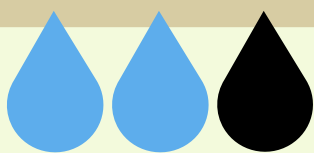
### LIGHTING



Mailiki Lime prefers bright light -- and it'll make sure that the bright variegated leaves keep their various colours as it grows!



### WATERING



Dracaenas can dry out practically all the way, but prefer to be watered when the soil is about halfway dry.



### HUMIDITY

Dracaenas don't care much about the ambient humidity! Don't worry too much about it for this one.



### FUN FACTS

Philodendron Silver Sword is a very quick grower if you give it support and enough light -- it can grow upwards of 3-4' in a single year, even indoors!
