It's a remarkably easy-care plant, as well -- and propagates easily if a vine breaks!

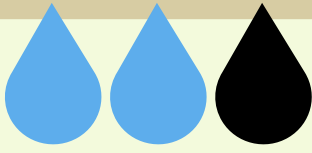
LIGHTING



Goldfish plants need lots of light so that they can give you lots of blooms -- they'll even bloom year-round in enough light!



WATERING



Your Goldfish Plant likes to be kept consistently moist, but it hates wet feet above all else, and the leaves are semi-succulent -- so you can let it dry out a bit as well!



HUMIDITY

These are rainforest plants from Brazil -- so they want higher humidity than most households are, but they're resilient and adaptable if needs be.



FUN FACTS

This is often sold as a 'Columnea', which is a genus that also has the common name of 'Goldfish Plant', but the flowers aren't actually all that similar-looking!
