Hoya Macrophylla

Hoya macrophylla / Hoya latifolia

Hoya Macrophylla is a relatively large-leaved variety of hoya with very prominent, ridged veins and a line of variegation around the margins of each leaf. This variegated area comes in bright pink if in bright light, then fades to a creamy white as the leaf hardens off







No hoya needs much in the way of watering -- use the taco test! If you can (gently!) fold a leaf in half like a taco, then it's time to water!



HUMIDITY

Higher humidity than the average household is helpful for Hoya Macrophylla, but it's not necessary!



FUN FACTS

Hoya Macrophylla and Hoya Latifolia have nearly identical foliage and are both in circulation -- so you likely don't know which you have!
