The Philodendron Birkin is ubiquitous at this point, and it's not hard to see why -- with huge, glossy leaves boldly striped with white, this self-heading philodendron, sibling of the possibly even more famous Pink Princess, is bold and bushy as it grows larger!

Like most Philodendrons, your Birkin has medium watering needs -- let the top V3 or so of the substrate dry out before watering it again!





Philodendron Birkin is pretty adaptable as far as humidity goes -it will appreciate higher humidity, but it's okay with less!
