

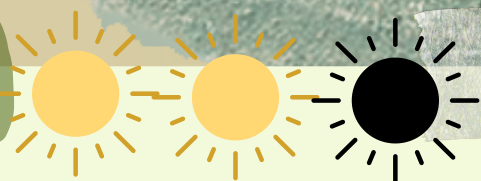
Philodendron Melanochrysum

Philodendron melanochrysum

Philodendron melanochrysum is a gorgeous climbing philodendron that seems to sparkle in the light, especially mature leaves. In fact, "melanochrysum" means "black and gold", referring to the gold sparkles against the nearly-black mature leaves!

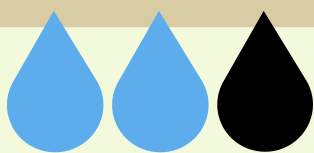
LIGHTING



Brighter growth will encourage quicker growth and larger leaves, but *Melanochrysum* is pretty happy with medium-bright situations.



WATERING



Like most *Philodendrons*, your *Melanochrysum* has medium watering needs -- let the top $\frac{1}{3}$ or so of the substrate dry out before watering it again!



HUMIDITY

Philodendron Melanochrysum is pretty adaptable as far as humidity goes -- it will appreciate higher humidity, but it's okay with less!



FUN FACTS

Philodendron Melanochrysum's leaves can be upwards of two feet long -- particularly if you give them support to climb!
