LIGHTING



Bright light is needed for big leaves and copper tones, but it'll survive medium-bright light as well.



WATERING



Like most Philodendrons, your Summer Glory has medium watering needs -- let the top 1/3 or so of the substrate dry out before watering it again!



HUMIDITY

Philodendron Summer Glory is pretty adaptable as far as humidity goes -- it will appreciate higher humidity, but it's okay with less!

Philodendron Summer Glory has some of the largest leaves in the genus!
