Featuring crisp-yet-soft Daisy yarn from K1C2 - a unique blend of linen, silk and hemp!



Yarn:	Tools:	Gauge:
"Daisy" 38% linen, 32% silk, 30% hemp, 214 yards x 2 skeins	Knit: US #6 40" circulars; #8 for bind-off Crochet: G (4.00mm) crochet hook	Knit: 4.25 st x 8.5 rows = 4" in pattern Crochet: 2 full arches (w&l) = 3"/7cm


Knit Project (shown left, above) Abbreviations:

Rnd = round
S2kpo = Slip 2, k1, pass slipped stitches over knit stitch
YO = yarnover (an increase of 1 stitch)

Knit Pattern Directions

Using the long tail cast on method, Cast On (CO) 248 sts. Place marker for beginning of rnd and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist the stitches on the needle.

Rnd 1: Knit.
Rnd 2: Purl.
Rnd 3: *Purl 1, YO, S2kpo, YO; repeat from * to end of the rnd.
Rnd 4: Knit rnd.
Repeat Rnds 3 & 4 till piece measures 10.5" (26.67 cm).
Then, Knit 1 rnd and Purl 1 rnd.
With larger needle loosely bind off (BO).
Block to finished measurements of 29" wide x 10" long.



Over for crochet pattern...

Crochet Pattern (shown right, front)

Abbreviations:

beg = beginning
dc = double crochet
lp = loop
sc = single crochet
sp = space
st = stitch
rp = repeat
yo = yarn over
tr = treble crochet

Construction Overview: Make a 80" x 8" long rectangle, then attach both ends together to create the infinity scarf. Pattern is a multiple of 9, plus 2, in case you want to make it wider or skinner.

Instructions:

Ch 47, turn

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *[ch 3, skip next 3 ch, sc in next ch, ch 5, sc in next ch, ch 3, skip next 3 ch, sc in next ch], rep from * across until the end of the row, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *[skip next 3-ch loop, 11 dc in next 5-ch loop, skip next 3-ch loop, sc in next sc], rep from * across until the end of the row, turn.

Row 3: Ch 4, skip first sc, skip next 4 dc, *[dc in next dc - ch 3 - dc in next dc - ch 3 - dc in next dc, skip next 4 dc, skip sc, skip next 4 dc], rep from * across, ending with skip last 4 dc, tr in last sc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, skip dc, *[3 dc in next 3-ch loop, ch 3, skip dc, 3 dc in next 3-ch loop, skip 2 dc from previous row], rep from * across, end with dc in 4th beg ch, turn.

Row 5: Ch 6, skip 4 dc, *[sc - ch 5 - sc in next 3-ch loop, ch 3, skip 3 dc, dc in between 3rd and 4th dc, ch 3], rep from * until the end of the row, ending with dc in 3rd beg ch, turn.

Row 6 to end: Repeat rows 2 to 5 for pattern until yarn is almost over, make sure to finish with row 2 and enough yarn to sew both ends together. Block and enjoy!
