

# Katy

*A delicate knit poncho, designed by Tracy Keeter for LoopsClub*



Yarn:	Tools:	Gauge:
One "superskein" of Marina from Manos del Uruguay, 1311 yds Merino lace	#4 24-32" circular needle <b>or size needed to obtain gauge</b>	7 sts = 1"

Cast on 138 stitches. Setup rows: Knit 2 rows.  
 Row 1 (RS) and all odd rows except 25: sl2 wyif, knit to end  
 Row 2: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 30 times, knit to end (137)  
 Row 4: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 29 times, knit to end (136)  
 Row 6: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 28 times, knit to end (135)  
 Row 8: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 27 times, knit to end (134)  
 Row 10: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 26 times, knit to end (133)  
 Row 12: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 25 times, knit to end (132)  
 Row 14: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 24 times, knit to end (131)  
 Row 16: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 23 times, knit to end (130)  
 Row 18: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 22 times, knit to end (129)  
 Row 20: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 21 times, knit to end (128)  
 Row 22: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 20 times, knit to end (127)  
 Row 24: k1, k2tog, \*yo, k2tog\* 19 times, knit to end (126)  
 Row 25: sl2 wyif, knit to end, cast on 12 stitches  
 Row 26: knit

Repeat rows 1-26 20 more times.

Bind off very loosely or with stretchy bind-off method of choice.

Wet-block your piece to open up the lace stitches and create a roomier poncho. Ours was approx. 22.5" wide x 55" long (on the garter side) and 64" long (on the eyelet side) after blocking.

Seam or graft the bind-off edge of your rectangle to the end of the opposite long side to form poncho.



# Solomon's Knot Whisper Wrap

A crochet wrap by Kara Gunza



**Materials:** One "superskein" of Marina from Manos del Uruguay, 1311 yds Merino lace\*\* and Size "B" 2.25mm crochet hook

**Measurements:** Finished shawl measures 18" x 38" as written and blocked. \*\*There is plenty of yarn in your superskein to make a piece at least twice this size. It can easily be made larger by adding an even number of Solomon's Knots (sk) on row 1.

**Abbreviations:** See <http://www.petalstpicots.com/resources/crochet-abbreviations/>

**Solomon's Knot (sk):** Draw up a loop on your hook about 1/2-in tall, chain 1, single crochet through back loop of long chain

**Directions:**

Ch 2.

Row 1: Work 1 sc in 2nd chain from hook, work 110 sk across (or longer if desired to an even number of sk), turn.

Row 2: Work 2 sk, skip 1st sc from previous row and work 1 sc in next sc (this will be the 5th sc from your hook), \*work 2 sk, skip next sc and work 1 sc in the following sc, repeat from \* across, turn.

Row 3: Work 3 sk, skip 1st sc from previous row and work 1 sc in next sc (this will be the 5th sc from your hook), \*work 2 sk, skip next sc and work 1 sc in the following sc, repeat from \* across, turn.

Rows 4 through 35: Repeat Row 3 until Row 35 or until desired width is reached, turn.

**Edging:** Ch 1, 1 sc in first sc from previous row, \*ch 4, [1 sc, ch 1, 2 dc, ch 1, 1 sc] in next sc, ch 4, 1 sc in next sc, repeat from \* across top edge of piece, down side edge, then across bottom edge and remaining side.
